SUNDAY AFTERNOON: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-1 at Dozer Park.](#)

Peoria took a 2-0 lead on a two-run home run by Jeremy Rivas in the bottom of the fourth inning. Wisconsin scored on a solo homer by Eduarqui Fernández in the sixth inning. The Rattlers could not rally and got swept in the six-game series at Peoria.

MISSED OPPOTUNITIES: Ernesto Martínez Jr doubled as the lead-off batter in the top of the third inning, but he was still at second when the inning ended. Darrien Miller doubled to lead off the top of the seventh inning and a wild pitch sent him to third with no outs. He was left stranded when the inning ended. Wisconsin went 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position on Sunday. The Rattlers also had two hits in the ninth inning, but a double play wiped out the comeback possibility.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU? Eric Brown singled in the ninth inning to move his current hitting streak to six games. He is 8-for-22 during the streak, the longest streak by a Wisconsin hitter this season.

MILLER TIME: Miller had two hits on Sunday and is on a five-game hitting streak.

TOUGH DECISION: Wisconsin starting pitcher Joseph Hernandez allowed two hits in four innings on Sunday. Unfortunately, those hits were a lead-off triple by Victor Scott II and the home run by Rivas and Hernandez was charged with the loss.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend are 15-12 on the season. They are tied with Peoria for second place in the Western Division. Both teams are 1-1/2 games behind first-place Beloit. In their most recent series, the Cubs went 2-4 at home against Cedar Rapids. South Bend starts a series at Beloit on May 16.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#15), Eduardo García (#21), and Joseph Hernandez (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#2), Cade Horton (#4), James Triantos (#11), Kevin Made (#15), and Kohl Franklin (#25). Ed Howard (#22) has not played this season and is on the South Bend Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner [lost at Peoria on May 3](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on seven hits with a walk and a strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Wagoner has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. In his final appearance of 2022, Wagoner beat Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs on [September 10](#). He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings as a reliever.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON BIRDSSELL: The Cubs selected Birdsell in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of Texas Tech.

GETTING TECHNICAL : Birdsell was 9-3 with a 2.75 ERA in fifteen starts in his final season at Texas Tech. He walked 29 and struck out 106 over 85 innings and was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year. Birdsell pitched two seasons for Texas Tech was 13-4 with a 2.84 ERA and 142 strikeouts over 120-1/3 innings.

SEARCHING FOR A HOME: Birdsell began his collegiate career at Texas A&M in 2019 and transferred to San Jacinto Junior College for the 2020 season before going to Texas Tech.

DELAYED DEBUT: The Cubs did not have Birdsell pitch in a game as a professional after signing him last season. He made his first pro appearance with three scoreless, hitless innings as a reliever [at Quad Cities on April 9, 2023](#).

LAST START: Birdsell had a [no decision at home against Cedar Rapids on May 3](#). He allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out five over five scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Birdsell has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
