ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-4 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Wisconsin had a 4-2 lead before the Kernels scored three runs in the top of the eighth inning. Eduardo Tait hit a two-out, two-run homer to put Cedar Rapids ahead. Wisconsin left the bases loaded in the bottom of the eighth and couldn't take advantage of a lead-off double by Josiah Ragsdale in the bottom of the ninth. The Rattlers went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position on Saturday as their six-game winning streak came to an end. The longest winning streak by the Rattlers since moving to High-A in 2021 remains an eight-game streak from August 26 through September 3, 2023.

HE GETS ON BASE: Josiah Ragsdale was 1-for-3 with two walks and a run scored to extend his on-base streak to 31 games, the longest by a Timber Rattler player this season. Ragsdale is 44-for-118 (.373) with 23 walks, 35 runs scored, and an OPS of 1.051 during the streak. He also stole his 24th base of the season last night.

GET OUT OF HERE! Braylon Payne hit his fifteenth home run of the season last night when he cracked a two-run home run in the bottom of the third. He extended his current hitting streak to ten games with that homer. He is 16-for-42 (.381) during the streak.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS: Eric Bitonti went 1-for-5 last night to move his own hitting streak to a season-high seven games. He is 15-for-31 (.484) during the streak.

STRONG START: Jayden Dubanewicz was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers last night. He allowed two runs on one hit with three walks and five strikeouts. He retired the first nine batters he faced.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Wisconsin begins a six-game series against the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park on Tuesday night. The Rattlers are 10-8 against the Chiefs so far this season.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended in 2024 when the Kernels missed the playoffs but started again in 2025 when they advanced to the Midwest League Championship Series. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRAYLON OWENS: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Owens in the tenth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Texas-San Antonio.

FOUR SEASONS AS A ROADRUNNER: Owens spent all four seasons of his college career at UTSA. He was 14-7 with four saves and a 4.76 ERA in 63 games – 22 starts – in college. Owens had 196 strikeouts in 181-2/3 innings at Texas-San Antonio.

VICTORIAN AGE: Owens pitched three summers for the Victoria Generals of the Texas Collegiate League and went 10-1 with a 2.76 ERA in eighteen games – fourteen starts with the Generals.

NO PRO: Owens did not pitch professionally after signing with the Brewers. He was 7-2 with three saves in 21 games – fourteen starts – as he helped the Roadrunners make the NCAA tournament and advance to a Super Regional against the UCLA Bruins in his final season.

NAILED IT DOWN: Owens earned the save against Texas in the Austin Regional on [May 31, 2025](#). He allowed a run on a hit with seven strikeouts over the final four innings to lock down a 9-7 win over the Longhorns. Owens was named to the All-Regional Team for his performance.

A MAJOR AWARD: The Brewers named Owens as their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May.

LAST START: Owens beat the Kernels in game one of the series on [June 23](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over five scoreless innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Owens is 2-0 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He also earned the win at Cedar Rapids on [June 3](#) by allowing one run on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BAILEY OBER: The Minnesota Twins selected Ober in the twelfth round of the 2017 draft out of College of Charleston.

REHABBING: Ober was placed on Minnesota's Injured List on May 31 with right elbow inflammation.

2026 SO FAR: Ober was 6-3 with a 4.59 ERA in twelve starts for the Twins before the stint on the IL.

A PRESENCE NOT FELT SINCE....: Ober pitched for the Kernels in 2018. He was 7-1 with a 3.84 ERA in fourteen starts. Ober walked nine and struck out 88 in 75 innings pitched with Cedar Rapids that season.

LAST START: Ober lost at Pittsburgh on [May 30](#). He allowed eight runs – seven earned – on twelve hits over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Ober was 1-0 in three starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2018. He allowed seven runs on sixteen hits with two walks and 29 strikeouts over 17-2/3 innings pitched.
