#### **INDY BITS**

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A trio of runs in the sixth inning propelled the Indians to a 3-2 victory over the Columbus Clippers on Friday night at Victory Field. Trailing by a run in the bottom of the sixth inning, the Indians tagged Will Dion for four consecutive singles off the bats of Nick Solak, Jack Suwinski, Eli Wilson and DJ Stewart. A Brett Sullivan sacrifice fly capped the inning's scoring to give Indianapolis a 3-1 advantage it did not relinquish. With both teams scoreless in the top of the fifth frame, Columbus plated the first run of the contest when a C.J. Kayfus sacrifice fly brought home Kyle Datres, who had singled to lead off the inning. Columbus brought the game to within one in the eighth when Kody Huff homered off Hunter Stratton, but the threat ended there. In his Triple-A debut, Hunter Barco tossed 4.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits with five punchouts while walking three. Yohan Ramírez earned the win, throwing 1.2 innings in relief, yielding one hit with a strikeout.

ALL BARC': Hunter Barco turned in a solid performance in his Triple-A debut last night, tossing 4.1 innings of one-run ball with two hits, three walks and five strikeouts. He allowed his first run of the season after not allowing a run in his six starts with Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings in Double-A to begin the season, the longest scoreless streak in Curve history. In seven starts this season between Altoona and Indy, Minor League Baseball's No. 100 overall prospect owns a 0.30 ERA (1er/30.0ip) with 13 hits, 10 walks, four hit batters and 39 strikeouts. He has held opposing hitters to a .131 average (13-for-99) and boasts a 0.77 WHIP.

**SOLAK ECLIPSE:** Nick Solak is on a scorching run to begin the 2025 season, ranking among International League leaders in batting average (.380, 35-for-92, 1st), OBP (.448, T-2nd), OPS (1.057, 4th) and SLG (.609, 4th). He went 3-for-4 with one run in last night's win, matching a season-high with his fourth three-hit performance on the campaign. He has reached base safely in 24 of 27 games this season and has one-plus hit in 23 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. Solak hit .400 (20-for-50) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, 11 runs, three stolen bases and a 1.056 OPS in that span, with that streak being tied for the third longest in the International League this season. He struck out just seven times across 55 plate appearances during the hitting streak. He was named the Indians April Player of the Month yesterday after he led the team in batting average, hits, total bases, home runs, RBI, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS across 20 games. Solak hit .394 (28-for-71) with 16 runs, two doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, six walks, three stolen bases and a 1.070 OPS in April. In addition to his team-leading marks, he ranked among International League qualifiers in batting average (2nd), OPS (4th), slugging percentage (5th, .634), hits (T-6th) and on-base percentage (7th, .436). His batting average was the highest by an Indians batter in a single month since Gregory Polanco hit .400 in April 2014. He reached base safely in 19 of 2012 arms in April

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis on Tuesday. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. Horwitz went 0-for-4 both yesterday and on Wednesday. On Tuesday, he went 2-for-4 with one double and one run. Moreta threw 1.1 innings last night, allowing one run with one hit, one walk and two strikeouts. He tossed a scoreless sixth inning on Tuesday with one walk, striking out the side.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean picked up his third save of the season on Thursday, escaping a bases-loaded jam with two outs in the ninth inning to seal the Indians 4-3 win. With the shutout frame, Yean extended his scoreless outing streak to eight games. It is the longest run by an Indy player this season and tied for the sixth longest active run in the International League. He also escaped a bases loaded jam with 1.1 scoreless innings on Tuesday. In this span, he has blanked opponents across 10.1 innings with nine hits, six walks, eight strikeouts and three saves. This, opposed to allowing four runs, five hits, five walks and just one strikeout in his first 2.1 innings this season.

ELI'S BACK: Eli Wilson debuted at third base last night after being reinstated from the development list, entering the game in the bottom of the fourth inning after Malcom Nuñez was injured legging out a double. Wilson went 1-for-2 with one RBI and one run. He has one-plus hit in all four of his games this season and he extended his RBI streak to three games. Both of those streaks are the longest active runs on the team.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Columbus Clippers tonight at 6:35 PM, with a chance to clinch the series with a win. It would mark Indy's second series victory of the season and would put them at an even 2-2-2 series record. It would be their first series win over Columbus since the week of June 19-25, 2023. Taking the mound for Indianapolis is right-hander Thomas Harrington, who is set to make his fifth start and sixth appearance of the season. He took his second loss in his previous start on May 4 at Omaha, tossing 5.0 innings with five hits, five runs, one walk and two strikeouts. He allowed a career-high them home runs in the defeat. He made one career start against the Clippers on Aug. 23, 2023, at Columbus, earning the win with 6.0 innings, two hits, one run, no walks and six strikeouts. Opposite Harrington is Clippers left-hander Parker Messick. Messick has made six starts for Columbus this season, posting a 1-1 record and 3.25 ERA (10er/27.2ip) with 20 hits. 13 walks, three hit batters and 39 strikeouts. He is set to make his first career start against Indianapolis.

ON THIS DATE IN 1984: Mike Stenhouse recorded the fourth three-homer game in franchise history vs. Evansville at Bush Stadium. In a 17-4 victory for the Indians, Stenhouse went 3-for-5 with a team-leading eight RBI. Ron Johnson hit a home run of his own, going 4-for-4 with two RBI and five runs scored. Right-hander Greg Bargar went the distance and struck out 11 batters to earn the win. Stenhouse spent 27 games with Indianapolis in 1984, hitting .333 (31-for-93) with eight home runs and 27 RBI.
