OPPORTUNITY KNOCKED: Wisconsin had runners at second and third with one out in the bottom of the first inning after Jadher Areinamo singled and Blake Burke doubled. Whitecaps starting pitcher Joe Miller struck out the next two batters to deny the Rattlers a run. Wisconsin did not put another runner in scoring position for the rest of the game.

MULTI-MAN: Areinamo had two of Wisconsin's four hits yesterday for his third straight game with two hits. Areinamo leads Wisconsin with nine multi-hit games

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants - 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTHONY FLORES: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent on June 4, 2022.

ON AN ISLAND: Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

COMING TO AMERICA: Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Flores allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with a walk and a strikeout over four innings of relief in game one of the series against the Whitecaps on <u>April 29</u>. Izaac Pacheco homered against Flores in that game.

LAST START: Flores had a no decision against Lansing at home on April 17. He allowed three runs on four hits with no walks and four strikeouts. The Lugnuts also hit two homers off Flores in the game.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: The relief appearance on April 29 is the only time Flores has faced the Whitecaps.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KENNY SERWA: The Detroit Tigers signed Serwa as a minor league free agent on January 22, 2025 off the Chicago Dogs of the Independent American Association.

TRAVELING MAN: Serwa pitched at four colleges from 2016 through 2022. He made one appearance at St. Joseph's (IN) in 2016, missed the 2017 season, pitched for Southern Illinois-Edwardsville from 2018 through 2020, went to University of Central Florida in 2021, and University of Dayton in 2022. Additionally, Serwa played for Lafayette in the Prospect League in 2021 and for Billings in the independent Pioneer League in 2022.

MY KIND OF TOWN: Serwa was 6-6 in twenty games – nineteen starts – for the Chicago Dogs in 2024. He walked 23 and struck out 103 in 119-1/3 innings with a 4.22 ERA.

PURE MICHIGAN: Serwa made his debut in affiliated baseball on April 5, 2025 with four perfect innings with four strikeouts against the Dayton Dragons at home.

LAST APPEARANCE: Serwa allowed a run on a hit and two walks with a strikeout over 3-2/3 innings in game one of the series against the Rattlers on April 29.

LAST START: Serwa lost at Dayton on April 23. He allowed three runs on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.
