ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 17-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Wisconsin had a 3-0 lead after the bottom of the second inning. The Sky Carp scored a run in the third, two runs in the fourth, four runs in the fifth, five runs in the sixth, and five runs in the ninth for seventeen unanswered runs. Colby Shade was on base six times and Michael Snyder drove in six runs.

EARLY GOING: Wisconsin took a 1-0 lead on an RBI single by Juan Baez in the first. Yhoswar Garcia hit a two-run homer, his first home run in the Midwest League, in the bottom of the second to give the Rattlers their three-run lead.

ONSLAUGHT: Beloit had seventeen hits, drew thirteen walks, and went 9-for-21 with runners in scoring position. Wisconsin used position players Luiyin Alastre and Daniel Guilarte to pitch the ninth inning.

PERFECT TEN: Blake Burke went 1-for-4 with a single last night to extend his current hitting streak to ten games to match Jadhoe Areinamo for the longest streak on the team this season. Burke is 13-for-41 (.317) during the streak. Burke is also on a 17-game on-base streak (23-for-68, .937 OPS)

SPEAKING OF STREAKS: Garcia and Baez both extended their own hitting streaks last night. Garcia is 9-for-25 during his current a seven-game hitting streak. Baez is on a six-game hitting streak (8-for-22).

PRESSED INTO SERVICE: Alastre started the top of the ninth inning for the Rattlers and allowed five runs on three hits and two walks. He recorded two outs, including a strikeout of Yiddi Cappe. Guilarte got the final out of the ninth, but not before allowing two walk and a two-run single by Snyder.

THE LIGHT OF DAY: Today is the fourteenth day game of the season for Wisconsin. They are 7-6 in day games this season, including 4-4 at home.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season. He also pitched six scoreless innings in Game Two of the First Round of the 2023 Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats,

2024: Aquino made twenty appearances – ten starts – for Wisconsin last season. He was 3-4 with two saves and a 3.65 ERA. Aquino had 57 strikeouts and 23 walks in 79 innings as a Rattler last year.

LAST APPEARANCE: Aquino earned the save at Peoria on [May 8](#). He pitched two scoreless, hitless innings with a walk and two strikeouts.

LAST START: Aquino lost at Quad Cities on [August 6, 2024](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Aquino was 2-0 in three games – two starts – against the Sky Carp last season. He allowed four runs – three earned – on ten hits with six walks and sixteen strikeouts over 15-2/3 innings.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NOBLE MEYER: The Miami Marlins selected Meyer in the first round of the 2023 draft out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. Meyer was picked with the tenth overall selection.

ON THE CHARTS: Meyer is rated as the #5 prospect in the Miami Organization by MLB Pipeline. Meyer is ranked at #98 on MLB Pipeline's Top 100 Prospect List. *Baseball America* places Meyer as the #3 prospect in the Marlins system.

BACK TO THE FUTURE: Noble Meyer represented the Marlins on the National League team in the 2024 Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas on [July 13](#). Meyer was the winning pitcher after pitching a scoreless, hitless second inning with a walk and two strikeouts.

HOW WE GOT HERE: Meyer made his pro debut in 2025 with five brief starts between the Florida Complex League and the Jupiter Hammerheads of the Florida State League. He was 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA and fifteen strikeouts over eleven innings pitched as a pro in 2023. Meyer started the 2024 season with Jupiter where he was 2-2 with a 2.68 ERA and 43 strikeouts over 34 innings pitched in eight starts before his promotion to Beloit on May 28. As a member of the Sky Carp last season, Meyer was 0-5 with a 5.18 ERA in eleven games – ten starts. He walked 32 and struck out 42 in 40 innings.

LAST START: Meyer had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on [May 7](#). He allowed five runs on two hits, four walks, and four hit batsmen with four strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Meyer was 0-1 in two starts against the Rattlers last year. He allowed three runs on three hits with eight walks and nine strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings.
