ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians surged to a 3-0 lead in the first inning and matched a seventh-inning rally from the Nashville Sounds with one of their own in the eighth as they took Sunday's series finale at First Horizon Park, 7-3. With one out in the first frame, Ji Hwan Bae kicked off the Indians' rally with a walk and scored on a double from Nick Solak. Solak moved to third on a single from Billy Cook, who went on to steal second, setting up Nick Yorke to knock in two runs with a single to give Indy a lead they would not relinquish. Jared Triolo did the heavy lifting in plating the Indians' fourth run in the fourth inning, reaching via a walk, stealing second base and scoring on a wild pitch after advancing to third on a ground out. Cook extended Indianapolis' lead to 5-0 with a 103.9 mile-per-hour solo shot in the fifth, his fourth homer in July after posting only one prior to this month. Drew Avans broke up the shutout for Nashville and sparked a Sounds rally with a solo home run of his own in the seventh. The Sounds scratched across two more runs before Eddy Yean stonewalled their rally with a double play. Indianapolis wasted no time punching back in the eighth inning. Matt Fraizer doubled and scored on a single from Ronny Simon and Bae followed with a triple to cap Indy's lead. Drake Fellows tossed a gem for Indianapolis, allowing four hits, two walks and striking out two across 5.0 scoreless innings. Cook and Solak led the way for Indy's offense, both notching three-hit efforts. Each of Indianapolis' first five hitters in the lineup, including Cook and Solak, recorded an RBI in the contest and eight of nine Indians hitters picked up a hit.

FABULOUS FELLOWS: Drake Fellows' outing on Sunday was his second consecutive start of 5.0 scoreless innings dating back to July 12 vs. Gwinnett. This marked the first time he's tossed consecutive starts of 5.0-plus scoreless innings since June 29-July 16, 2021 (also two starts), while with the FCL Pirates (Gold). In five starts since June 25, Fellows has earned a 2-1 record with a 2.61 ERA (6er/20.1ip) and has held opponents to a .186 batting average (13-for-70).

VICTORY FIELD (LITERALLY): The Indians return home to Victory Field, where they've won 10 of their last 12 games played since June 27 and 28 of their last 35 since May 11. On the season, Indianapolis leads all full-season minor league clubs with 38 wins and a .745 winning percentage (38-13). Indy's home winning percentage is its highest to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing a .692 clip (36-16) through July 21, 2012. Indianapolis' highest winning percentage in a full season in the Victory Field era (since 1996) is .681 (49-23) in 1997. The Indians' pitching staff has excelled at Victory Field, racking up the most strikeouts (525) of any Triple-A team at home while holding the third-lowest batting average against (.226) and the fourth-lowest ERA (3.57).

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Indy jumped all over Nashville's starter, RHP Logan Henderson, on Sunday, tagging him for four runs across 3.2 innings. With the win, the Indians improved to 45-26 (.634) when opposed by a right-handed starter this season. Their .634 winning percentage against righty starters is the second highest in Triple-A this season and 45 wins are tied for the second most. Indianapolis is currently pacing International League offenses with a .283 batting average and a .361 on-base percentage against right-handed starters while ranking third with a .807 OPS.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae smacked his third triple of the month in Sunday's win. He is the first Indians hitter since Matt Gorski in May 2024 to tally three or more triples in a month. Bae has reached base safely in 35 of 40 games on the campaign and in 13 of his last 15 since June 28. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with 12 runs, one double, three triples, nine RBI, nine walks, seven stolen bases and an .841 OPS in 16 games. Additionally, Bae has not made an error this season, converting on all 72 chances between the three outfield positions.

BUCCO BORUCKI: LHP Ryan Borucki had his rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton to Indianapolis on Friday last week. He made one rehab appearance with Bradenton on July 8, tossing a scoreless inning with one strikeout before being transferred to Indianapolis. He is one of eight rehabbers assigned to Indy on nine separate stints this season. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on June 21 with low back inflammation after going 1-3 with a 5.26 ERA (15er/25.2ip) in 29 appearances with Pittsburgh. The reliever has made 23 appearances with Indianapolis since joining the Pirates organization, logging a 2.31 ERA (6er/23.1ip) and 31 strikeouts. 20 of his outings with Indy have been scoreless and he has not allowed a hit in 14 of those.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak recorded three hits, including a double, on Sunday, marking his ninth three-hit game of the season, which is tied or the fourth most among International League hitters. Solak also extended his team-best on-base streak to 28 games since June 10, which is the third-longest active run in the International League. His on-base stretch is the longest by an Indian since Ji Hwan Bae also reached base in 28 straight from April 27-June 1, 2022. Across his streak, Solak is hitting .349 (37-for-106) with 22 runs, six doubles, three home runs, 15 RBI, 15 walks, two stolen bases and a .931 OPS. He has hit safely in 25 of those 28 games, including a team-high tying 14 game hitting streak from June 12 (1)-27. On the season, Solak owns the highest batting average (.366, 85-for-232) of qualified full-season minor league hitters while ranking fifth in on-base percentage (.438) and seventh in OPS (.998).

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians begin a six-game series against the Toledo Mud Hens, Triple-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at 7:05 PM from Victory Field. Indy has won its last five games against Toledo at Victory Field after dropping Game 1 of their six-game set at Victory Field earlier this season from April 15-20. Righty Thomas Harrington will take the bump for Indy for his 17th start and 18th appearance of the season. Through three starts in July, Harrington has a 2-0 record with a 3.21 ERA (5er/14.0ip). Additionally, he's pitched to a 2-1 record with a 2.65 ERA (5er/17.0ip), a 0.94 WHIP and a .169 batting average against (10-for-59) in three Tuesday starts this season. Harrington has made four starts against the Mud Hens to the tune of a 4.50 ERA (10er/20.0ip) with 15 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP. He will be opposed by fellow RHP Wilkel Hernandez, who has pitched to a 0-1 record with a 3.48 ERA (4er/10.1ip), 10 strikeouts and a 0.68 WHIP in two starts against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 2013: Indianapolis set a new franchise record for margin of victory on the road in a 17-1 win at Charlotte. Three Indy hitters, Brian Bocoock, Ivan De Jesus Jr. and Alex Presley had three hit games, with Bocoock and Presley combining for seven RBI. Two of Bocoock's knocks were triples, which matched a team-high in the Victory Field era. The previous highest margin of victory on the road was 14 runs, when the Indians beat Syracuse, 16-2, in 2006. Indy eventually bested its road record in 2017, beating Columbus, 21-1.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates No. 4 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Harrington allowed three runs on four hits, no walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work on July 13 vs. Gwinnett.

Quality in Quantity: Harrington strung together three straight quality starts from June 3-14, and pitched to a 2-1 record with a 2.50 ERA (5er/18.0ip), 18 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP in that stretch. He is the first Indians pitcher to record three straight quality starts since Cam Alldred did so from June 16-29, 2023.

Against the Mud Hens: Harrington has a 0-1 record with a 4.50 ERA (10er/20.0ip), 15 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP in four career starts against Toledo.

Miscellaneous: Harrington was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.

- » Currently rated as the No. 17 prospect in Pittsburgh's farm system according to MLB Pipeline.
