

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Fort Wayne TinCaps 6-3 at Neuros Group Field. Wisconsin trailed 3-1 heading into the bottom of the seventh inning. Eduarqui Fernández drove in a run with a two-out double to get the Rattlers to within a run. In the eighth, Matt Wood tied the game 3-3 with an RBI single. Ramón Rodríguez knocked in the go-ahead runs with a two-run double. Wood scored an insurance run on a wild pitch. Wisconsin has won four straight games with all four wins coming on their final at bat of the game. The Rattlers are 14 over .500 for the first time since July 13, 2022 (48-34).

IN CONTROL: Neither team issued a walk last night. Three Fort Wayne pitchers - Miguel Cienfuegos, Ryan Och, and David Morgan - walked none and struck out two. Three Wisconsin pitchers - Will Rudy, Stiven Cruz, and KC Hunt - walked none and struck out six. Last night was Wisconsin's third game of the season in which they walked none.

DOUBLING UP: Wisconsin matched its season high for doubles in a game with five last night. Fernández and Rodríguez both had two doubles with Gregory Barrios adding one.

MULTI-BALL: Barrios had three hits last night. He has fifteen multi-hit games this season. His double last night was his league-leading fourteenth of the season. RALLY TIME: The Timber Rattlers trailed after seven innings in the first three games of this series. Wisconsin had not won a game when trailing heading into the eighth inning prior this series. They have rallied to win the first three games against the TinCaps. STANDINGS CHECK: Wisconsin maintained their 1-1/2game lead in the West Division over the Cedar Rapids Kernels with last night's win. The Kernels beat Lake County last night.

ABOUT FORT WAYNE: The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started in Mattoon, Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torii Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

ABOUT THE PADRES: San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise for 1999. PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#7), Luke Adams (#15), Logan Henderson (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Gregory Barrios (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). MLB Pipeline has ten Fort Wayne players on their list of Padres prospects: Ethan Salas (#1), Dylan Lesko (#3), Homer Bush Jr (#8), Braden Nett (#16), Cole Paplham (#17), Jagger Havnes (#18), Garrett Hawkins (#24), Jav Beshears (#27), Bradgley Rodriguez (#28), and Henry Baez (#30).

# **PITCHING MATCHUP**

# WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOGAN HENDERSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Henderson in the fourteenth round of the 2021 draft out of McClennan Community College in Texas.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE: Henderson was the NJCAA's Pitcher of the Year in 2021 after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA and 169 strikeouts in 97-2/3 innings as he helped the Highlanders to win the NJCAA National Title. He had 31 strikeouts in two appearances, including 17 in eight innings in the title game, during the NJCAA College World Series.

PROSPECT WATCHING: MLB Pipeline rates Henderson as the #16 prospect in the Brewers system. Baseball America places him at #23.

**CAROLINA IN MY MIND:** Henderson did not pitch professionally in 2021 after the draft and needed elbow surgery during spring training in 2022. The surgery held him to 13-2/3 innings late in the season with 11-2/3 innings with the Carolina Mudcats. Henderson made up for lost time in 2023 as he went 4-3 with a 2.75 ERA in eighteen regular season starts for Carolina with 106 strikeouts over 78-2/3 innings. He also was the starting pitcher in Game Two of Carolina's playoff series with Down East. Henderson allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings for a no decision.

**SHORT SHOWCASE:** Henderson opened the 2024 season on the IL due to an injury to his left oblique that he suffered while pitching in the Spring Breakout Game against a team of Royals prospects on May 17. He worked his way to the Rattlers with two rehab starts for the ACL Brewers in which he pitched 4-2/3 scoreless innings with ten strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Henderson made his Timber Rattlers debut at South Bend on May 24. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with three strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings and was charged with the loss.

VS. FORT WAYNE: Henderson has never pitched against Fort Wayne prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the San Diego Padres.

## FORT WAYNE STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HENRY BÁEZ: The San Diego Padres signed Báez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic July 2, 2019. WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: Báez made his pro debut for the DSL Padras in 2021 as an 19 years and the way 0.2 in turking stress of the second str

Padres in 2021 as an 18-year-old. He was 0-2 in twelve games – ten starts – with a 4.25 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 36 innings pitched. **CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Báez pitched in the Arizona Complex

League in 2022 with a 1-4 record and a 3.82 ERA in nine games – seven starts. Last year, Báez began the season with Lake Elsinore in the California League and was 7-3 with a 3.24 ERA and 85 strikeouts over 83-1/3 innings over seventeen games – fourteen starts. He was bumped up to Fort Wayne in August and had no record and a 7.20ERA in four starts with the TinCaps.

LAST START: Báez had a no decision against Lansing at home on May 26. He allowed one hit over four scoreless innings with a walk and three strikeouts. Báez had started a game on May 24 against Lansing during the series but the game was suspended with two outs in the top of the second inning. Báez allowed two runs on one hit with three walks over 1-2/3 innings for a no decision in that game.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Báez has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The last time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers was on <u>June 27, 2022</u> against the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He allowed an unearned run on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over four innings.
