ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 14-9 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. The Rattlers led 6-2 after two innings, but the Cubs had a 9-6 lead heading into the bottom of the eighth. Wisconsin scored eight runs in the bottom of the eighth to take the lead for good.

GOING DEEP! There were five home runs last night. Dean Nevarez and Yonathan Perlaza each hit two-run home runs for the Cubs. Joe Gray Jr., Yeison Coca, and Korry Howell each hit homers for the Rattlers. Coca's home run was his first with Wisconsin since July 26, 2019. Gray's homer was his second of the season with the Rattlers, his first at home with Wisconsin, and his fourteenth overall between Carolina and Wisconsin. Howell's home run was his twelfth of the season.

ANATOMY OF A RALLY: Thomas Dillard singled to start the bottom of the eighth inning. South Bend got the first out of the inning, but the next three Rattlers walked with Chad McClanahan drawing the final free pass to drive in the first run. An errant throw on a force at second allowed three runs to score and Wisconsin was up 10-9. David Hamilton and Howell followed with RBI singles and Carlos Rodríguez capped the inning with a wo-run double. The eight-run inning matched the most runs in an inning by the Rattlers this season.

CLOSING THE GAP: Hamilton stole two bases more bases last night. He has 39 on the season. Devlin Zinn of South Bend had one stolen base for his 41 st of the season to hold onto the lead in Minor League Baseball in that category.

AMONG THE LEADERS: Gray has 61 RBI between Carolina and Wisconsin this season. He is third in MiLB in RBI. Brandon Lewis an Orelvis Hernandez lead MiLB with 63 RBI. Howell scored three runs last night to give him 57 this season and he is tied for fourth in MiLB in runs scored. Anthony Volpe leads MiLB in runs with 66.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Justin Upton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

TORO! TORO! Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA: Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Castañeda was assigned to the Rattlers on May 20, 2019. He was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during the 2019 season with the Rattlers.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Wek on September 25, 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance <u>at Cedar Rapids on May 28</u>. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game.

LAST START: Castañeda lost to the <u>Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park on July 18</u>. He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Castañeda did not face the Cubs in South Bend during the June series between the teams at Four Winds Field in June of this year. He pitched a scoreless hitless inning for a save against the Cubs on July 18, 2019 in his only appearance against South Bend.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MAX BAIN: The Cubs signed Bain as a minor league free agent on January 27, 2020.

NORTH...WHAT? Bain pitched spent four seasons with Northwood University, a college in Midland, Michigan, the home of the Great Lakes Loons. Northwood is an NCAA Division II university that plays in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR: Bain was 6-0 with a 2.78 ERA in 17 games – four starts – in his junior season. He followed that up by going 7-3 with a 4.17 ERA in 14 starts in his senior season. Bain recorded 162 strikeouts over 123 innings in his final two seasons at Northwood.

SUMMER ON THE SHORE: Bain played for the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League during the summer of 2019. He allowed fifteen runs – thirteen earned – on seventeen hits with 23 walks and 21 strikeouts over 24 innings pitched that season.

YOU MIGHT ALSO REMEMBER: Former Timber Rattlers Logan Gillaspie and Luis Contreras played in the USPBL. Current Minnesota Twins pitcher Randy Dobnak is also an alum of the USPBL.

LAST START: Bain <u>lost to Cedar Rapids at home on July 18</u>. He allowed four runs on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over three innings against the Kernels in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bain had a no decision against the <u>Timber Rattlers at Four Winds Field on June 11</u>. He allowed one run on four hits over 5-1/3 innings pitched. Bain walked two and struck out ten in the game.
