**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 12-4 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Wes Clarke hit two homers and drove in six runs to lead the offense and Justin Jarvis allowed three runs – one earned – with nine strikeouts over seven innings for his fifth win of the season.

**SLAMMED:** Clarke is the first Rattler to hit two home runs in a game and set a new single-game high for RBI by a Rattler this season with his performance last night. He had an RBI single in the first, a solo home run in the third, and a grand slam in the ninth. Clarke's grand slam was his second of the season for Wisconsin.

**KINGS OF TRIOS:** Clarke, Tyler Black, Tristan Peters, and Micah Bello each had three hits last night. The Timber Rattlers had seventeen hits in the game.

**JUSTIN CREDIBLE:** Jarvis is 4-0 in his last seven starts. He has allowed two earned runs with one walk and fifteen strikeouts over thirteen innings in June.

**DICEY SITUATION:** The Timber Rattlers had a 7-0 lead after the top of the fifth inning. Beloit scored a run in the fifth and two unearned runs in the sixth off Jarvis. The Sky Carp added a run in the eighth off Miguel Guerrero and had runners at the corners with two outs to bring the tying run to the plate. Cam Robinson took over and got a strikeout to end the threat.

**YOU'RE IN GOOD HANDS:** The Timber Rattlers scored five insurance runs in the top of the ninth.

**ABOUT БЕЛОИТ:** The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3](#). Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Evan Fitterer (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51<sup>st</sup> overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as the #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

**NO, CUBS, NO:** The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season.

**MISSING TIME:** Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith had a [no decision at Beloit on June 7 in game one of this series](#). He allowed two runs on seven hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings pitched. Smith set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with his performance in that game.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Smith has no record in two starts against the Sky Carp this season. He also [had a no decision at Beloit on April 14](#). He pitched four scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CHRIS MOKMA:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 12<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Holland (MI) Christian High School.

**BROI:** Mokma's brother Mike pitched for the Great Lakes Loons in 2021. Mike Mokma is currently pitching for the Everett AquaSox, the Northwest League affiliate of the Seattle Mariners.

**STARTING OUT/STARTING OVER:** Chris Mokma made five brief starts in the Gulf Coast League in 2019 and allowed three runs with two walks and twelve strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings for an 0-1 record. He made twenty starts for the Jupiter Hammerheads in Low-A in 2021 and was 2-7 with a 6.60 ERA with 78 strikeouts over 92-2/3 innings.

**LIKE ANOTHER PLANET:** Mokma started this season with the Hammerheads again and was 4-1 with a 3.58 ERA in six games – five starts – before gaining his promotion to Beloit on May 17.

**LAST START:** Mokma had a [no decision at Quad Cities on June 5](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Mokma has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
