ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians overcame a three-run deficit to knot the game in the ninth inning, but it wasn't enough as a grand slam by Matthew Batten in the top of the 10th gave the Gwinnett Stripers their first win of the six-game series at Victory Field on Friday night, 8-4. Down 4-2 in the bottom of the ninth, the Indians utilized an RBI triple by Tsung-Che Cheng and sacrifice fly by Ji Hwan Bae to tie the game before the gamewinning 10th. A single and intentional walk loaded the bases with one out before Batten smashed a no-doubt grand slam to left field against Nick Dombkowski. Gwinnett began the scoring on an RBI triple by Cody Milligan in the third inning before Bae scored Simon in the fifth to tie the game at 1-1. A pair of homers by Eddys Leonard and Sandy León in the sixth inning then gave the Stripers a three-run advantage. Indy began its comeback effort on a Liover Peguero RBI single in the eighth. Blake Burkhalter took the first five frames for Gwinnett before five bullpen arms finished the win. John Brebbia gave up the two game-tying runs before Wander Suero shut down the Indians offense in the bottom of the 10th.

HUNTING DOG: Hunter Barco did not factor into the decision in last night's contest, tossing 5.1 innings of three-run ball with four hits, a career-high tying four walks, one hit batter and four strikeouts. He has allowed three runs or fewer in eight of his 10 starts with Indianapolis this season and has gone 5.0-plus in five of them. He has tossed 5.0-plus innings in four straight starts for the first time since a four-game run with High-A Greensboro from May 11-30, 2024. Since June 24, he ranks among International League qualifiers in innings pitched (1st, 23.1), strikeouts (2nd, 24), AVG (3rd, .139), WHIP (6th, 0.81) and ERA (7th, 1.54). He holds the 11th-lowest ERA (2.00, 8er/36.0ip) in home games of Triple-A pitchers (min 25.0ip).

SUPER SAIYAN SIMON: Ronny Simon (0-for-4, R, BB, 2K, SB) has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games since June 11, including a 20-game on-base run from June 11, July 5, and has hit safely in 20 of those 25. In this 25-game span, he is hitting .293 (29-for-99) with 19 runs, six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, 18 walks, 14 stolen bases and a .903 OPS

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak (1-for-4, R, 2B, BB) extended his team-best on-base streak to 25 games yesterday, which is the third-longest active run in the International League. It is the longest on-base stretch by an Indian since Jake Lamb's season-best 27-game streak from April 18-May 27, 2024. Solak is hitting, 323 (31-for-96) with 20 runs, five doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 14 walks, two stolen bases and an .854 OPS in this stretch. He has hit safely in 21 of those 24 games, with a team-high tying 14 game hitting streak from June 12 (1)-27. He owns honors as the IL's top hitter with a .356 batting average (79-for-222) for the season. As the Indians lone representative on the league offensive leaderboard, he also ranks among qualifiers in on-base percentage (3rd, .427), OPS (5th, .968) and slugging percentage (10th, .541).

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae (2-for-4, 2 RBI, K) extended his hitting streak to seven games yesterday. It is his longest hitting streak since a season-high nine-game run from April 25 (1)-May 6. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with 10 runs, one double, two triples, five RBI, five walks, six stolen bases and a .905 OPS in 12 games. He has posted two-plus hits in back-to-back games and four of his

CHA CHENG: Tsung-Che Cheng (1-for-4, R, 3B, RBI, K) set up the Indians 9th-inning comeback with an RBI triple in last night's contest. He subsequently scored the game-tying run on a sacrifice fly by Ji Hwan Bae. He has hit safely in six of seven games this month, batting .320 (8-for-25) with five runs, one double, one triple, one home run, 8 RBI, two walks, one stolen base and a .930 OPS. He has driven in a run in three straight games for the first time since June 35-27, 2024, with Double-A HOMAN SARAD WITH A CONTROLLED opener, his first longball since Aug. 20, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Richmond.

BUCCO BORUCKI: LHP Ryan Borucki had his rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton to Indianapolis yesterday. He made one rehab appearance with Bradenton on July 8, tossing a scoreless inning with one strikeout before being transferred to Indianapolis. Borucki pitched a perfect 7th inning with two strikeouts in his season debut last night. He is one of eight rehabbers assigned to Indy on nine separate stints, joining infielder Jared Triolo, first baseman Spencer Horwitz, right-handed pitchers Dauri Moreta and Colin Holderman, catcher/first baseman Endy Rodríguez, infielder Nick Gonzales and catcher Joev Bart. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on une 21 with low back inflammation after going 1-3 with a 5.26 ERA (15er/25.2ip) in 29 appearances with Pittsburgh. He has held opposing lefties to the lowest batting average (.087, 4-for-46) of major league pitchers with at least 40 at-bats against left-handed hitters this season. The reliever has made 21 appearances with Indianapolis since joining the Pirates organization, logging a 2.61 ERA (6er/20.2ip) and 27 strikeouts. 18 of his outings with Indy have been scoreless and he has not allowed a hit in 13 of those.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Gwinnett Stripers tonight at 7:05 PM. RHP Drake Fellows is set to make his 21st appearance and seventh start of the season. Since joining the Indianapolis rotation on June 7, Fellows is 0-2 with a 7.52 ERA (17er/20.1ip), 23 hits, eight walks and 21 strikeouts. Tonight marks his first career game against the Stripers. Opposite Fellows is Gwinnett RHP Brett Sears, who is set to make his Triple-A debut. Sears has now climbed all four full-season levels in the minor leagues this season, collectively posting a 7-5 record with a 2.81 ERA (23er/73.2ip), 50 hits, 17 walks and 82 strikeouts. With a win tonight, Indy can secure its first series win over the Stripers since taking two of three games at Gwinnett from July 7-9, 2017, and first home series victory over them since two of three games from June 2-4, 2017.

ON THIS DATE IN 2003: A day after playing their first game at a newly opened Victory Field in downtown Indianapolis, the Indians won their first game there vs. Oklahoma City, 2-1. Mike Remlinger allowed just one run on two hits over 6.1 innings, and Indy's bullpen backed him by allowing just three hits over the next 2.2 innings. Pokey Reese went 2-for-4 and drove in Roberto Mejia twice.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: Indy's newest member of the rotation will be making his seventh start of the season and his 27th career start compared to 35 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows tossed 3.0 innings of two-run ball on July 6 vs. Louisville with one hit, two walks and four strikeouts.

Against the Stripers: Tonight is his first career appearance against the Stripers.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliver to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.
