

WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: The Wisconsin Timber
Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 10-6 at
Neuroscience Group Field. Wisconsin rallied from
deficits of 3-2 and 6-5 to win their second straight
game. The Rattlers scored five runs in the bottom of
the eighth inning to make the final push past the
Bandits. All Rattlers in the lineup had at least one hit.
Joe Gray Jr was 2-for-2 with three walks for Wisconsin.
SEEING DOUBLE: The Timber Rattlers collected eight
doubles out of their fourteen hits on Wednesday. Mike
Boeve had two doubles, including a double in the eighth
inning to put Wisconsin up 7-6. Robert Moore, Brock
Wilken, Gray, Alex Hall, Eduarqui Fernández, and
Jheremy Vargas each had doubles, too. The last time
Wisconsin had eight doubles in a game was against
Fort Wayne at home on July 20, 2016.
GIVE US SOME MOORE! Moore had a two-run homer
in the fifth and a game-tying RBI double in the eighth.

n the fifth and a c ame-tying RBI double Moore leads the Rattlers in RBI with 58. The homer was Moore's eighth of the season.

BROCK AND ROLL! Wilken's double in the seventh inning moved his hitting streak to six games (7-for-23). Wilken is also on an eleven-game on-base streak (12for-41) with seven walks.

PULLING THE WAGON: Cameron Wagoner allowed one run on two hits over five innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher on Wednesday. Wagoner is 3-0 in four games in August. ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Cornielle lost at Cedar Rapids on <u>August 17</u>. He allowed five runs on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings. Cornielle hit two batters and allowed a home run in the game, a 6-2 loss to the Kernels.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Cornielle has no record in three appearances – two starts – against the River Bandits this season. He made starts at Quad Cities on <u>April 23</u> and at home on <u>May 18</u> with a relief outing at Quad Cities on <u>June 29</u>. Cornielle has allowed six runs on ten hits with seven walks and ten strikeouts against the River Bandits this season. Gavin Cross hit a homer against Cornielle earlier this season.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CRUZ NORIEGA: The Royals signed Noriega as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 30, 2018.

A YEAR IN THE DOMINICAN: Noriega made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League in 2018. He was 2-4 with three saves and a 4.18 ERA. Noriega walked eight and struck out thirty over 32-1/3 innings.

ON TO ARIZONA: Noriega spent the 2019 season in the Arizona League and was 3-3 with a 5.11 ERA in thirteen games – five starts. He walked seventeen and struck out 37 in 44 innings.

THREE TEAMS; ONE SEASON: Noriega started his 2021 season with Columbia in the Carolina League with his final appearance with the Fireflies coming on August 11. He was placed on the Injured List on August 16 and made one rehabilitation start for both of Kansas City's affiliates in the Arizona Complex League. Noriega was 5-3 with a 3.97 ERA and a save in seventeen games – eleven starts with Columbia. He struck out 76 while walking just thirteen in 70-1/3 innings in Carolina League action.

A SEASON LOST: Noriega was placed on Columbia's 60-day Injured List on April 8, 2022 and he missed the entire season. The Royals activated Noriega on May 9, 2023 and sent him to Quad Cities.

LAST START: Noriega had a no decision against Beloit at home on <u>August</u> <u>17</u>. He allowed four runs on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts over four innings. Noriega allowed a homer in the game. Quad Cities was down 4-0 in the game and rallied for a 5-4 win after Noriega left the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Noriega has made three appearances – one start – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He was the starter at Wisconsin on <u>May 21</u> and made relief appearances at Quad Cities on <u>June 29</u> and <u>July 3</u>. Noriega allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings. Eric Brown Jr and Robert Moore have both homered against Noriega this season.
