ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 4-2 at ABC Supply Stadium. Alexander Cornielle allowed two runs and struck out nine over six innings for the win. Wisconsin broke a 2-2 tie with two, two-out runs in the top of the seventh to take the lead. Miguel Guerrero, Justin King, and Shane Smith each worked a scoreless, hitless inning out of the bullpen to close out Wisconsin's sixth win in a row.

STEALING VICTORY: There were two outs with none on in the top of the seventh when Eric Brown Jr singled, stole second, and went to third on an error. Luis Lara singled home Brown with the go-ahead run before he stole second and went to third on an error. A dropped flyball on what would have been the final out of the inning allowed Lara to score an insurance run.

FIRST! Cornielle earned his first win of the season with his performance last night. He walked one batter and the only runs he allowed happened on a two-out RBI double in the third and another two-out RBI double in the sixth.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Milwaukee Brewers pitcher Aaron Ashby has been sent to the Rattlers to make a brief rehabilitation start against the Sky Carp tonight. If all goes well, Ashby could make another start for Wisconsin at home next week. Ashby missed the entire spring training camp and had arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder on April 7.

SIX-PACK: The Timber Rattlers have won six games in a row for the first time this season. Wisconsin had two six-game winning streaks in 2022. The Rattlers have not had a seven-game winning streak since 2014.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED RELIEF PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Woessner made his first relief appearance of the season on <u>August 25</u> when he took over in the fourth inning against the Quad Cities River Bandits at home. Julio Teherán made a rehab start for the Rattlers in that game. Woessner allowed four runs – three earned – on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

LAST START: Woessner lost at Cedar Rapids on <u>August 18</u>. He allowed five runs on five hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT: Woessner is 0-1 in two starts – <u>April 28</u> and <u>July 6</u> – against the Sky Carp this season. He has allowed five runs on twelve hits with four walks and two strikeouts over twelve innings against Beloit in 2023.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KARSON MILBRANDT: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty (MO) High School. He is the #15 prospect in the Marlins system according to MLB Pipeline.

IS IT IN YOU? Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Player of the Year for Missouri prior to the 2022 draft. He was 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 50-2/3 innings pitched. He also hit .400 with an OPS of 1.043 in his senior season.

VANDERWHAT? Milbrandt signed with the Marlins over a commitment to Vanderbilt University.

STARTING OUT: Milbrandt made one professional appearance in 2022, a two-inning start for the Jupiter Hammerheads against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on September 9 in a Florida State League game. He allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and a strikeout for a no decision.

LEAVING JUPITER: Milbrandt started this season with the Jupiter and was 3-3 with a 5.33 ERA in twelve starts. He walked 26 and struck out 52 in 52-1/3 innings pitched before being assigned to Beloit on June 28.

LAST START: Milbrandt lost to Lake County at home on <u>August 26</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on five hits with no walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Milbrandt had a no decision at Wisconsin on July 8. He pitched four scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked four, and struck out three. Milbrandt had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to the game on July 8. That was also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
