ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs won a pair of games from the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers at Four Winds Field. The Cubs won the completion of Wednesday's suspended game 5-3. South Bend took the seven-inning game 7-4.

GAME ONE RECAP: Wisconsin had a 2-1 lead when play was halted on Wednesday night. The Cubs scored two unearned runs in the bottom of the sixth after a dropped flyball that would have been the third out. The Rattlers tied the game with an unearned run of their own in the top of the seventh on a sacrifice fly by Andrew Fischer. Brian Kalmer broke the 3-3 tie with a two-run home run in the bottom of the eighth.

GAME TWO RECAP: The Cubs scored three runs in the bottom of the first inning and had an answer for every Wisconsin rally. The Rattlers best chance to get back in the game happened in the sixth inning. They pulled to within 6-3 on an RBI single by Luiyin Alastre and had the bases loaded with one out. They would not score again in the inning and the Cubs added an insurance run in the bottom of the sixth.

MARCO DINGERS: Marco Dinges homered in the top of the fourth inning in the second game last night. It was a solo shot for his ninth home run as a Rattler. He went 3-for-7 with two walks, four runs scored, and two RBI in the two games that were completed on Thursday.

SEARCHING FOR A HIT: In the seven-inning game, Wisconsin was 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position and 0-for-2 with the bases loaded. The Rattlers are 17-for-106 (.160) with the bases loaded this season.

DOWN THE STRETCH: Beloit won their game while Quad Cities lost last night. The Cubs were eliminated last night with Beloit's win because the Sky Carp have the tiebreaker on South Bend.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1992. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRAVIS SMITH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Smith in the fifteenth round of the 2024 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILDCAT: Smith pitched two seasons at Kentucky and was 7-7 with a 5.44 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 86 innings in 26 games – nineteen starts.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Smith made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League in 2025. He was 4-4 with a 3.20 ERA in nineteen starts. Smith walked twenty and struck out 57 over 76 innings with the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Smith lost to Quad Cities at home on [August 30](#). He allowed five runs on seven hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Smith has never pitched against the Cubs prior to this evening. He has no record [two starts](#) against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, earlier this season as a member of the Mudcats. Smith allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with one walk and seven strikeouts over six innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BROOKS CAPLE: The Chicago Cubs selected Caple in the ninth round of the 2024 draft out of Lamar University.

CARDINAL RULE: Caple pitched two seasons at Stephen F. Austin University before transferring to Lamar for the 2023 and 2024 seasons. In his senior season at Lamar, Caple was 7-3 with a 2.40 ERA, 102 strikeouts, 27 walks, and a WHIP of 0.87.

AWARD SEASON: Caple was as two-time All-Southland Conference selection and was the Southland Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2024. *Baseball America* named him Third-Team All-American last year.

LIFE ON THE BEACH: Caple did not pitch professionally in 2024. He began this season with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans of the Carolina League. Caple was 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA in seven starts for the Pelicans. He walked fourteen and struck out 30 over 35 innings before his promotion to South Bend on May 27.

LAST START: Caple lost at Peoria on [August 29](#). He gave up four runs on five hits with a walk and a strikeout over three innings..

VS. WISCONSIN: Caple won at Wisconsin on [July 8](#) when he allowed four runs on eight hits with a walk and four strikeouts over six innings. He also had a no decision against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, on [April 13](#). The Mudcats scored three runs on three hits with two walks over four innings against him in that game. Caple struck out two Carolina hitters.
