LAST ACTION: The South Bend Cubs beat the <u>Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-1 at Neuroscience Group</u> <u>Field</u> on Wednesday afternoon. Ed Howard put South Bend up 2-1 with a solo homer in the top of the seventh. The Cubs scored two runs in the seventh and added two more runs in the ninth. Wisconsin left eight runners on base and went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position in the game on Wednesday.

FASTBALLS AT 60'-6": Both starting pitchers went five scoreless innings. Patricio Aquino allowed three hits with no walks and a strikeout for Wisconsin. Drew Gray allowed one hit with two walks and four strikeouts. THE BOOK OF LUKE: South Bend took the lead on a

sacrifice fly by Jefferson Rojas in the top of the sixth inning. Luke Adams homered in the bottom of the sixth to tie the game. Adams has homered in two straight games. He leads the Rattlers with eleven home runs this season.

**DEBUT:** Reliever Tyler Bryant made his Timber Rattlers debut Wednesday. He allowed a walk and a single to the first two batters he faced in the top of the eighth inning. Bryant retired the next three batters to pitch a scoreless inning.

ESCAPE PLAN: The Cubs had two runs in, and the bases loaded with one out in the top of the ninth. Aaron Rund was called in from the bullpen and he got the final two outs with on a pair of strikeouts to strand all three runners. Rund has inherited sixteen runners this season and only six have scored.

MAKING A RUN: The Timber Rattlers have 199 stolen bases this season. Wisconsin needs to average 1.38 stolen bases per game over the final 34 games of this season to set a new club record

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager. ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several

different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), and Patricio Aquino (#28). Jadher Areinamo (#21) is on the Wisconsin IL. MLB Pipeline has six South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Jefferson Rojas (#7), Drew Gray (#10), Pedro Ramirez (#12), Jaxon Wiggins (#19), Will Sanders (#25), and Brett Bateman (#27).

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP K.C. HUNT: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Hunt as a non-drafted free agent on July 20, 2023.

**ORIGINALLY:** Hunt was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the twelfth round of the 2022 draft out of Mississippi State University. Hunt elected not to sign with the Pirates and returned to Mississippi State.

**HAIL STATE:** Hunt pitched four seasons with the Bulldogs. He went 4-6 with three saves in 53 appearances – three starts – at Mississippi State. Hunt had 102 strikeouts over 81 innings pitched in college.

**HOT FUN IN THE SUMMERTIME:** Hunt pitched for three teams in three leagues over four summers while in college. He was with Portland in the West Coast League in 2019, Falmouth of the Cape Cod League in 2021 and 2023, and Trenton of the MLB Draft League in 2022.

**BEFORE WISCONSIN:** Hunt made his pro debut with the ACL Brewers in 2023 with four relief appearances in the regular season and two relief stints during the 2023 ACL playoffs. Hunt made eight relief appearances with Carolina this season and was 3-0 with a save, a 2.48 ERA, 32 strikeouts, and four walks over nineteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 14, 2024.

SO, WHAT DOES K.C. STAND FOR? Kyle Clemente Hunt was named after Roberto Clemente, his father's favorite baseball player. Mickey Hunt is K.C.'s dad and was also his high school baseball coach at Ramapo (NJ) High.

**LAST START:** Hunt had a no decision at Beloit on <u>July 25</u>. He allowed a run on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Hunt has no record in two games – one start – against the Cubs this season. He has allowed two runs on seven hits with two walks and thirteen strikeouts over nine innings.

#### **SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP WILL SANDERS: The Chicago Cubs selected Sanders in the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the University of South Carolina.

**HEAD START:** Sanders pitched for Lexington County in the Coastal Plain League in 2020 before he ever pitched an inning at South Carolina. He was 2-1 with a 7.29 ERA in nine games – two starts. Sanders walked ten and struck out 22 over 21 innings pitched.

**HE WAS GAME:** Sanders pitched three seasons for the Gamecocks from 2021 through 2023. In 51 appearances – 36 starts – Sanders was 17-10 with a 4.08 ERA. Sanders had 222 strikeouts and 68 walks in 205-1/3 innings pitched at South Carolina.

**SIGNING DAY:** Sanders signed his contract with Chicago on July 19, 2023. He did not pitch in a professional game after joining the Cubs organization. Tonight is his pro debut.

**LAST START:** Sanders had a no decision against Peoria at home on July 25. He allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and five strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Sanders is 1-1 in three starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed nine runs – five earned – on ten hits with five walks and eight strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings.
