**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 4-1 at Dozer Park.](#) Je'Von Ward broke a 1-1 tie with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the sixth inning and Thomas Dillard hit a two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning to provide some insurance. Four Wisconsin pitchers combined to hold the Chiefs to a run on three hits. They also struck out 15 batters last night.

**KAHLE IS GOOD FOR YOU:** Nick Kahle put Wisconsin up 1-0 with an RBI double in the top of the second inning. Kahle is 4-for-11 with a homer, two doubles, and four RBI in the three games in this series.

**BULLISH:** Justin Bullock allowed a run on two hits over five innings and earned his fifth win with Wisconsin this season. He is 3-0 against Peoria since his promotion to the High-A Central League.

**DILLY DILLY!** Dillard hit his eleventh home run of the season with his blast in the eighth inning last night. It was his second home run as a right-handed hitter. He leads Wisconsin in homers and RBI (53).

**LOST SOULS SWIMMING IN A FISHBOWL:** Taylor Floyd entered the game in the bottom of the sixth inning with two outs, the bases loaded, and the bases loaded. Floyd struck out Francisco Hernandez to end the inning. Floyd has inherited 23 runners this season and only three have scored. He also struck out seven over 2-1/3 innings last night. Floyd has 51 strikeouts over 35-2/3 innings this season.

**SAVE ON RYE:** Evan Reifert pitched a perfect ninth for his second save of the season. He has not allowed a run in six consecutive appearances. Reifert has given up three hits and struck out 17 over 9-1/3 innings in those last six appearances dating back to June 29.

**ON THE EDGE OF EVEN:** Wisconsin has a chance to get back to the .500 mark with a win tonight. The Rattlers haven't been at .500 since they were 18-18 on June 13.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983.

They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. Chris Swauger is back as the manager of the Chiefs this year. Swauger managed the Chiefs in 2017 and 2018 when Peoria was in the Midwest League. The Chiefs made the Midwest League Championship Series but lost to Bowling Green in the Finals under Swauger in 2018. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has two current Chiefs on their list of St. Louis prospects: Jordan Walker (#6) and Jhon Torres (#7). Ian Bedell (#11) is on the Peoria IL.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP DYLAN FILE:** Selected by the Brewers in the 21<sup>st</sup> round of the 2017 draft out of Dixie State University in St. George, Utah.

**STARTING IN MONTANA:** File was 1-2 in twelve games – seven starts – for Helena in the Pioneer League after being drafted by the Brewers. He walked thirteen and struck out 37 over 47 innings during his first pro season.

**FORWARD TO WISCONSIN:** File was 8-10 with a 3.96 ERA in 25 starts with Wisconsin in 2018. He had 114 strikeouts in 136-1/3 innings pitched. File was a Mid-season All-Star and finished fifth in the Midwest League in innings pitched that season.

**THAT'S A GREAT SEASON:** File was 15-6 in 26 starts between Carolina (High-A) and Biloxi (Double-A) in 2019. He walked 22 and struck out 136 over 147 innings pitched at the two stops in the Brewers system. File was 6-4 and was named a Mid-season All-Star in the Carolina League. He went 9-2 with a 2.79 ERA after his bump to the Southern League.

**PRETTY GOOD POSTSEASON, TOO:** File was 1-0 in two playoff starts for Biloxi during the Southern League playoffs in 2019. He allowed one earned run, walked one, and struck out 15 in 14-1/3 innings during the Shuckers playoff run.

**WHAT DID YOU DO IN 2020?** File was invited to participate in Milwaukee's Alternate Training Site Camp last year.

**SO...THIS IS FORTY:** File was placed on Milwaukee's 40-Man Roster on November 20, 2020. He is currently on the 60-Day IL as he rehabs from a surgery on February 4, 2021 to repair a stress fracture in his right elbow.

**LAST START:** File had a no decision for the ACL Brewers Blue in a game against the [ACL Athletics on July 13, 2021](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and two strikeouts.

**VS. PEORIA:** File went 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA in three starts against the Chiefs in 2018.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER

**RHP CONNOR LUNN:** The Cardinals selected Lunn in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 season out of USC.

**TROJAN HORSE:** Lunn was an All-Pac-12 selection in 2019 as a junior. He was 7-4 in 15 games – eleven starts – with a save, a 3.69 ERA, and 79 strikeouts in 83 innings pitched

**AS A PRO IN 2019:** Lunn made twelve relief appearances with the State College Spikes in the New York-Penn League after signing with the Cardinals. He had no record, struck out 20, and walked six in 18-1/3 innings with the Spikes.

**LAST START:** Lunn lost [at Cedar Rapids on July 11](#). He allowed two unearned runs on two hits with one walk and no strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Lunn is 1-0 with two no decisions in three starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at [Dozer Park on May 13](#) and another [at Neuroscience Group Field on June 5](#). The Chiefs rallied two win – 3-2 on May 13 and 12-9 on June 5 – after Lunn left each game. Lunn beat Wisconsin in the Fox Cities [on June 23](#) when he allowed a run on six hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over seven innings. He has allowed ten runs – nine earned – on 21 hits with two walks and 19 strikeouts over 16-1/3 innings against the Timber Rattlers this season.
