ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-3 at Modern Woodmen Park. Quad Cities broke a 3-3 tie with a run in the bottom of the fifth and added three runs in the bottom of the seventh. Daniel Vazquez drove in three runs and scored two for Quad Cities. The River Bandits outhit Wisconsin 13-5. Wisconsin had one hit after the fourth inning, a lead-off single by Luiyin Alastre in the

ON ASSIGNMENT: Robert Gasser made the start for the start for the Timber Rattlers last night. He pitched the first inning, allowed two runs on one hit, and walked one on his rehabilitation start from the Milwaukee Brewers.

EVEN STEVEN: Alastre brought the Rattlers within a run on a two-out. RBI triple in the second. Bryan Gonzalez had an RBI single in the bottom of the second to give the River Bandits a 3-1 lead. Wisconsin tied the game with Jadher Areinamo stealing third and scoring on a throwing error in the third and an RBI grounder by Alastre in the fourth.

SIX-PACK: Alastre is on a six-game hitting streak, his longest of the season. He is 11-for-25 (.440) during the streak. Alastre is 22-for-72 (.306) with a .710 OPS in 21 games during the second half.

AREINAMO APPRECIATION: Areinamo doubled, stole two bases, and scored a run for the Rattlers last night. He is the Midwest League leader in hits (106), and total bases (166). In 208 games with Wisconsin, Areinamo has 236 hits, 54 doubles, 114 runs, and 119 RBI. His career OPS as a Rattler is .788.

WELCOME: Steward Berroa is in the lead-off spot as the DH for Wisconsin tonight as he starts a Minor League rehab assignment. He was acquired from the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 9, 2025. Berroa has played for the Buffalo Bisons in the Toronto system and Oklahoma City Comets in the Dodgers system earlier this season.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. In the July 25, 2025 update, Rodriguez is back at #30. Baseball America lists Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 Prospect Handbook.

LAST START: Rodriguez won at Cedar Rapids on <u>July 19</u> for his first Midwest League victory. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out three over five scoreless innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Rodriguez has no record in two starts – <u>April 10</u> and <u>June 25</u> – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings versus Quad Cities in 2025.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED RELIEVER:

RHP FELIX ARRONDE: The Kansas City Royals signed Arronde, a native of Cuba, to a minor league contract on June 28, 2021 just after he turned eighteen.

RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Arronde as the #18 prospect in the Royals system. *Baseball America* slots him at #17 in the Royals organization.

COLUMBIAN EXHIBITION: Arronde spent 2021 and 2022 in the Dominican Summer League. He split time between the ACL and the Columbia Fireflies in 2023. Arronde repeated the Carolina League in 2024 and was 4-8 with a 2.94 ERA and 103 strikeouts with only 32 walks over 110-1/3 innings pitched. His WHIP last year was 1.02 and opponents hit just .205 against him.

LAST APPEARANCE: Arronde had a no decision at Peoria on <u>July 19</u> as the starting pitcher. He allowed a run on two hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Arronde has no record in two starts against the Rattlers - <u>April 9</u> and <u>June 27</u> – this season. He has allowed one run on five hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings.
