**DES MOINES, IOWA** – The Omaha Storm Chasers held control of Wednesday's game from the very start and scored runs in seven of nine innings while connecting for four home runs to beat the Iowa Cubs 10-6 at Principal Park.

- ✦ **Nick Pratto** laced a two-out RBI double into the left-center field gap in the top of the 1st inning, then the Cubs tied things up with home run from MLB rehabber **Seiya Suzuki** in the bottom of the frame.
- ✦ **CJ Alexander** opened the top of the 2nd inning with Omaha's first of four long balls in the afternoon and the Storm Chasers held a lead the rest of the way.
- ✦ **Tyler Gentry** added a solo homer in the 3rd inning, then **Samad Taylor** singled in a run in the 5th inning, his league-best 13th RBI of the season.
- ✦ **Logan Porter** doubled in a run in the 6th inning and promptly scored on **Tucker Bradley's** first Triple-A home run, a two-run shot that at the time put Omaha up 7-3.
- ✦ While Iowa responded with one in the 5th and three in the 6th, each time countering Omaha, the Chasers pulled away in the final two frames, as **Nick Loftin** connected for a solo homer that led off the 8th, his third of the season, then proceeded to double in two in the 9th to double the margin of lead to four runs, the 10-6 that held to be final.
- ✦ Chasers starter **Austin Cox** went a season-best 4.0 innings in his second start, striking out five and retiring the final four hitters he faced ... **Jackson Kowar** followed Cox and allowed four runs over two innings of work but earned the win as he struck out four.
- ✦ After Kowar allowed an RBI double with two outs in the 6th, Iowa did not reach base the rest of the game as he combined with **Josh Taylor**, **Nick Wittgren** and **Josh Staumont** to retire the final 10 batters of the afternoon. Storm Chasers pitchers fired five 1-2-3 innings in Wednesday's win, the five innings where the I-Cubs did not score a run, while the staff combined for 10 strikeouts and walked just two, both issued by Cox.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

**Samad Taylor** has led off all 11 games this season for the Omaha Storm Chasers and gone 18-for-51 at the plate, with 6 extra-base hits and 13 runs batted in.

- ✦ Taylor has collected multiple hits in seven different games this season, including each of the first four, with hits in 10 of the 11 games he's played.
- ✦ His 11 hits and 13 runs batted in are BOTH tied 1st in the International League, a while he's tied 4th with 29 total bases.

#### WHAT DO YOU FERMIN?

After a slow start to the season, catcher **Freddy Fermin** has bounced back in the last couple of games and has hits in seven consecutive plate appearances.

- ✦ Fermin went hitless in his first five games of the season, beginning the year with an 0-for-19 stretch at the plate that carried into his sixth game of the season, on Friday, April 7th ... his first hit of the year came on a single to left field in the 5th inning on 4/7.
- ✦ In the 10 plate appearances since snapping his hitless streak, Fermin is 8-for-19 with a double, three home runs and six runs batted in ... he went 3-for-4 with 2 HR and 6 RBI on Saturday vs. Toledo, then 4-for-4 with 1 HR and 2 RBI yesterday vs. Iowa.

#### HOMER HAPPY

Omaha's 23 home runs through the first 11 games of this season have combined to account for 39 runs, or 48.1% of the team's total scoring (81 runs scored).

- ✦ 23 homers are the most not just of any International League team but the most in Triple-A and all of the Minor Leagues, two ahead of the Albuquerque Isotopes
- ✦ Six players have stolen bases this season, including four that have swiped multiple bags: **Dairon Blanco** (6), **Samad Taylor** (3), **Tucker Bradley** (3) and **Maikel García** (2) ... Blanco lead the league lead in steals and is tied in Minor League Baseball.
- ✦ Omaha lead the International League in steals for the first eight games of the season through Sunday, but now sit tied 4th in the league, behind leaders Memphis (21).

#### DON'T GO STEALING MY BASE

11 games into the season, the Chasers have stolen 16 stolen bases and are 16-for-19 in steal attempts ... Omaha began the season 12-for-12 on the basepaths, but the team went FOUR games without stealing a base before **Dairon Blanco** swiped one yesterday.

- ✦ Six players have stolen bases this season, including four that have swiped multiple bags: **Dairon Blanco** (6), **Samad Taylor** (3), **Tucker Bradley** (3) and **Maikel García** (2) ... Blanco lead the league lead in steals and is tied in Minor League Baseball.
- ✦ Omaha lead the International League in steals for the first eight games of the season through Sunday, but now sit tied 4th in the league, behind leaders Memphis (21).

#### ONE THOUSAND WINS

After managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 to 2013, **Mike Jirschele** returned in 2023 to manage the Storm Chasers, his 15th season at the helm in Omaha and won his 1,000th game with the Triple-A Omaha franchise last Saturday.

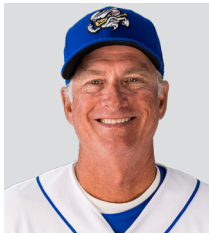

## MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHLE • 36

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Witheridge during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Witheridge's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



## PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • 59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



## HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



## BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • 33

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



## CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.



## STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH: YANNICK PLANTE

- Yannick Plante is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
- He began with the Kansas City Organization in 2019 as the athletic trainer for the Burlington Royals (Advanced Rookie, Appalachian League). He was then a staff member of the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.
- Plante has a master's degree in kinesiology from the University of Calgary and a bachelor's degree in human kinetics with specialization in biophysics from the University of Ottawa. He currently lives in Ottawa, Ontario.

## MIKE JIRSCHELE WINS 1000TH GAME AS OMAHA MANAGER

**PAPILLION, Neb.** – The Omaha Storm Chasers are excited to congratulate manager **Mike Jirschele** on his 1000th win managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise, as the Storm Chasers beat the Toledo Mud Hens 13-8 Saturday afternoon at Werner Park.

Now in his third stint at the helm of the Omaha Triple-A club, 2023 marks Jirschele's 32nd season with the Royals organization, his 18th as a Minor League manager (all within Kansas City's system) and 15th as the skipper at Triple-A Omaha.

Jirschele first managed the Omaha Royals from 1995 to 1997, a period where he won 216 games over three seasons. After a stint as a Minor League roving instructor for the Kansas City Royals from 1998 to 2002, Jirschele returned to Omaha in 2003 and managed the club again for 11 more seasons through 2013, a season that ended with a Triple-A National Championship. With 995 wins over his first two stints and 14 seasons with the Omaha Royals and Storm Chasers, "Jirsch" returned to Werner Park in 2023 to manage the club and entered the season five wins away from his 1,000th with the organization.

With a season-opening weekend sweep over Indianapolis March 31 – April 2 and a 9-4 win over Toledo on Friday, April 7, Jirschele entered Saturday one win away from the milestone and secured the victory, thanks to a four-homer effort from the Omaha offense.

*"1,000 wins is a really big number at the highest level in our organization. It shows the impact he's had on so many players and his impact on the Kansas City Royals organization itself," said Kansas City Royals Director of Player Development **Mitch Maier**. "When you start looking at the grand scale, the impact is what comes to mind for me – for the organization, direct impact for players who put on the uniform in Kansas City. It's a major impact for the organization and the players at the highest level before reaching the Major Leagues.*

*"I think of Jirsch when I think of loyalty and growing this game. 1,000 wins and all the players that were a part of those teams he managed make you realize how much time and commitment he has given to the game."*

Jirschele's first win in Omaha came as a 36-year-old on Thursday, April 6, 1995, an 8-7 win in 13 innings over the Iowa Cubs at Rosenblatt Stadium. His 500th win with Omaha took place 12 years later, in the second game of a doubleheader on May 15, 2007, a 2-1 win over the Fresno Grizzlies in seven innings at Rosenblatt Stadium.

Having managed three seasons in the Royals organization (1992-1994) prior to leading the Triple-A Omaha club, Jirschele picked up his 1000th overall managerial win on May 23, 2011. That season, he won the Mike Coolbaugh Award for "outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field." He is also a four-time recipient of Kansas City's Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), which recognizes outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.

*"The affect that Jirsch has had in Omaha and throughout professional baseball is vast," said Storm Chasers President **Martie Cordaro** said. "Not only has he positively impacted players and coaches lives, but front office staff and fans as well. Having worked with Jirsch for seven plus seasons, I can tell you that his efforts he has committed to the Royals' organization are unrivaled. His jersey, number 23, is retired in Omaha for many reasons and 1,000 wins is yet another example."*

After making the playoffs with the Omaha Royals in 1995 and 1996, Jirschele returned the club to the postseason in the first year at Werner Park in 2011. In his second stint as Omaha's manager, Jirschele led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships (2013).

Jirschele joined the Royals' Major League coaching staff on October 25, 2013 and was named Kansas City's third base coach on May 29, 2014. He spent six seasons in that position through the 2019 season and won the World Series in 2015. Prior to returning to Omaha in 2023, he most recently served as the bench coach under manager **Chris Widger** during the 2022 season with the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Royals Double-A Affiliate). He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits (Royals High-A Affiliate) and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.

He began his coaching career in 1990 as a player-coach for Class-A Appleton, then served as a coach the following year in 1991, both seasons under manager **Joe Breeden**. Jirschele began his managerial career in 1992 as the manager of the Gulf Coast League Royals (Royals Rookie Affiliate) and was named GCL Manager of the Year, as he led the team to a 41-18 record and league title. After managing the Midwest League's Rockford Royals (Royals Class-A affiliate) to a playoff appearance in 1993, Jirschele led the Carolina League's Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals Advanced-A affiliate) to a 94-44 record and Mills Cup Championship in 1994, named Minor League Manager of the Year by The Sporting News, also his first of four seasons as the Dick Howser Award recipient.

Originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the 5th round of the 1977 June Amateur Draft, he played 999 Minor League games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems, including 23 games for the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989. When he was named Omaha's manager in 1995, he became the third former Omaha player (of now six) to go on to manage the club.

The Omaha Storm Chasers will honor the milestone throughout the remainder of the season, including when the team returns home to Werner Park the week of April 18-23 for a series against the Gwinnett Strippers. More details will be released closer to the date.
