TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Shuckers at MGM Park. This is the second of five series' between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 27 times. The M-Braves are on their longest road trip of the season, which includes 12 games (6 at BLX, 6 at PNS) from April 25 to May 7. The Shuckers took two of three in the Opening Weekend series at Trustmark Park from April 7-9.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever has quietly put together a solid start to the season. He has saves in back-to-back games, and across 11.0 innings, Barger has 13 strikeouts to four walks, in seven appearances, allowing no runs, and is T3rd in the league in saves.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: Biloxi evened the series at 2-2 on Friday night with an 8-3 win despite the M-Braves out-hitting Biloxi 11-10. Freddy Zamora hit a pair of home runs, and the Shuckers led from start to finish. **Andrew Moritz** got the M-Braves on the board in the fifth inning with his first home run of the season, and finished 2-for-4. **Drew Lugbauer** was 2-for-4 with two doubles, and an RBI, and **Cade Bunnell** was 2-for-4.

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: **Javier Valdes** and **Drew Campbell** hit back-to-back solo home runs in the fifth inning on Tuesday, the second time the M-Braves have had back-to-back homers. **Drew Lugbauer** and **Hudson Potts** hit back-to-back home runs on April 15 at Chattanooga.

"STARTIN' TO COME TOGETHER PEPPER": After starting the season 3-10, the M-Braves have won four of six since Saturday's walk-off grand slam by Jacob Pearson. Over the last seven games, M-Braves hurlers have a 2.31 ERA, which ranks third in Double-A, trailing Portland (1.66), and Richmond (2.15).

THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B **Drew Lugbauer**, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer has a club record 49 home runs over parts of three seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

RETURN OF THE DEAN: OF **Justin Dean** returns to the M-Braves roster -- transferred from Triple-A Gwinnett. In 19 games, the Mauldin, SC native was batting .196 with a triple, home run, nine RBI, 14 walks, four stolen bases, and a .371 OBP. Dean has a .235 career batting average over 177 games played for the M-Braves, from 2021-2022. Dean has the longest-measured home run for Gwinnett this season, 427 feet, on April 2 vs. Jacksonville.

The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 49th M-Braves home run on Saturday at Chattanooga. He has three homers in 2023, tied for third in the Southern League.

STREAKING: **Cal Conley** has reached base safely in 9-straight game, since 4/18. He's batting .242, with a .302 OBP.

"IT WAS WORTH THE WAIT": Jacob Pearson's grand slam ended an eight-game losing streak, tied for second longest in club history. The walk-off grand slam was the first hit of the season for Pearson, who entered the game in the inning before as a pinch runner.

THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP **Tanner Gordon** has won two-straight starts and now ranks 8th in the Southern League with a 2.18 ERA over four starts. He also ranks among the league leaders in innings pitched (5th, 20.2 IP), WHIP (7th, 0.92), and opponents' average (9th, .190). He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect

The M-Braves lost nine games in a row twice in club history. The M-Braves lost eight games in a row from July 17-25 during the championship-winning season in 2021.

ROLLIN' WITH RANGEL: Over **Alan Rangel's** last two starts, he has allowed just one run over 11.0 innings with no walks and 10 strikeouts. He currently ranks among the Southern League leaders in WHIP (T4th, 0.63), and opponents' average (7th, .161).

MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF **Cody Milligan** was placed on the 7-day IL on Tuesday (hand). He hit in 11 of 13 games. Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season. He slashed .271/.345/.326 with one home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.

"KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are T3rd in the Southern League with 18 homers - 14 coming on the road. Ten different players have at least one homer with Lugbauer leading the way with three.

BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP **Kyle Wilcox**, RHP **Beau Burrows**, IF **Luke Waddell**, C **Hendrik Clementina**, and LHP **Domingo Robles** have all been promoted to Gwinnett this season. OF **Jacob Pearson** and OF **Justin Dean** have spent time with Triple-A Gwinnett.

- Robles makes his fifth start of the season and third for the M-Braves. Robles made two starts for Triple-A Gwinnett before being transferred back to Mississippi on April 13.

- Robles earned his first win in Sunday's series finale against Montgomery, giving up just one run on four hits over 5.0 innings with three walks, and five strikeouts. The M-Braves won 3-2 in the homestand finale.
