YEAH, YEAH, SHUCK YEAH

The Shuckers enter today with wins in 4 of their last 5 games... Over that span, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 40-24 (+16), the 2nd-most runs in Double-A... The Shuckers have recorded 20 stolen bases over that span, the most in Double-A and the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball.

RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE set the Shuckers single-game record (since 2015) with 5 stolen bases on Wednesday against the Trash Pandas... O'Rae broke the previous record of 4 which was set and tied 7 different times... Through 17 games played, O'Rae is 2nd in the Southern League with 14 stolen bases... O'Rae is on pace for 107 stolen bases, which would shatter the previous franchise record of 52, set by OF JOHNNY DAVIS in 2017.

O'Rae needs 6 stolen bases over the final 6 games of April to become the 3rd Southern League player since 2005 with 20+ stolen bases in a month... O'Rae would join OF BILLY HAMILTON (PNS, Aug. 2012, 37) and OF CHANDLER SIMPSON (MTG, Aug. 2024, 25).

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

The Shuckers enter today with 22 home runs, the 2nd-most in the Southern League and tied for the 7th-most in Double-A... The 22 home runs are the most through 18 games in franchise history (since 2015) and tied for the 6th-most in the Southern League in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005)... The Shuckers are 1 of 17 Southern League teams to record at least 20 home runs through 18 games.

RUNNING DOWN A DREAM

The Shuckers enter today with 58 stolen bases, the most by a Southern League team through 18 games since 2005... The Shuckers have recorded 5+ stolen bases in 7 of 18 games, including 3 of the last 4... The Southern League stolen base record is 264 set by the 1989 Birmingham Barons.

The Shuckers need to average 1.7 stolen base per game the rest of the season to break the record... The lineup has averaged 3.2 per game to begin the season.

ALL ABOUT THE STREAKS

1B BLAKE BURKE (18g) and 2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE (17g) enter today with 2 of the 4 longest on-base streaks in the Southern League this season... Both players have reached base in every game played this season.

Burke enters today among the league leaders in home runs (1st, 7), extra-base hits (T-1st, 12), RBI (T-4th, 16), slugging percentage (3rd, .603), stolen bases (T-5th, 9) and OPS (8th, .971).

O'Rae enters today among the league leaders in on-base percentage (1st, .476), hits (2nd, 24), stolen bases (2nd, 14), average (2nd, .364), walks (T-4th, 14) and OPS (7th, .976).

HOME, SWEET, HOME

The Shuckers improved to 7-2 at Keesler Federal Park this season with a win on Thursday... Since the start of 2025, the Shuckers are 50-29 (.633) at Keesler Federal Park, the 4th-best mark by win percentage in Double-A... The Shuckers have outscored opponents 416-325 (+91) over that span, an average of 5.3 runs per game.

BREAKING THE CENTURY MARK

On Wednesday, the Shuckers set the franchise record for the fastest team to reach 100 runs, needing 17 games to reach the mark... This season, the Shuckers have set a franchise record for the fastest team to reach 20 home runs (14g), 50 stolen bases (17g) and 100 walks (14g).

I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHERS LIVE A NIGHTMARE

On Wednesday, SS/2B JESUS MADE became the 6th Double-A player since 2005 to record at least 100 plate appearances before their 19th birthday... The group includes OF BRYCE HARPER, who held a .256/.329/.395 slash line with Double-A Harrisburg in 2011.

Made's 160 wRC+ is the highest by a Southern League player in their age-19 or younger season (min. 80 PA) since Jason Heyward (189) in 2009 with the Mississippi Braves.

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by Baseball America.

Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (66 AB), Kevin McGonigle (94 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (87 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 45 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,452 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (2-1, 1.80) makes his 4th start of the season and 1st career start against the Trash Pandas... DeBerry enters today among the Southern League leaders in opponents average (1st, .128), ERA (2nd, 1.80) and WHIP (T-5th, 1.13)... DeBerry has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs or less in 4 consecutive starts dating back to 2025.
