Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (17-26) vs. Nashville Sounds (22-21)

JUMBO SHRIMP BESTED BY NASHVILLE 4-3

Nashville (22-21) took the lead for the final time in the sixth inning. Isaac Collins and Joey Wiemer were walked to start the inning and before Wes Clarke singled to load the bases. Brewer Hicklen followed with a single off Jacksonville (17-26) reliever Matt Andriese (L, 0-3) scoring Collins tying the game at three. Yonny Hernández then grounded into a double play that scored Wiemer to give the Sounds a 4-3 lead. After Nashville took the lead in the top of the first, Jacksonville evened the game on an RBI single in the second. The Sounds regained the lead 2-1 in the top of the fifth and Jacksonville answered on a three-run homer from Jonah Bride to take a 3-2 lead.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder Victor Mesa Jr. missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 34 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 39-for-141, slashing .277/.335/.475/.810 with seven doubles, seven home runs, 28 RBIs, 13 walks and 24 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 18.7 percent this season with Jacksonville.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 29 of Jacksonville's 43 games (67.4 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 11 of the last 12 contests and 14 of the club's last 16 affairs. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 13 of its last 14 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-16 in these affairs.

TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last 13 games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 80 runs (6.2 per game), which ranks as the ninth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 80 runs, a whopping 44, or 55.0 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 133 hits in 121.0 innings pitched with two outs, the second-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .270 with an .808 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the foourth- and fifth-highest marks at the level.

TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

After falling 4-3 on Friday vs. Nashville, Jacksonville has now dropped 15 of its last 16 games - its worst stretch since at least 2005. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 28th in Triple-A in batting average (.225), 29th in OBP (.311), 29th in SLG (.343), 29th in OPS (.654), T-25th in hits (122) and 29th in runs scored (55). On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered 150 hits, which is eighth and tied for the 9th-most runs (94) on the seventh-worst BAA (.272) and 11th-worst OPS-against (.803).

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 35-for-115 (.304/.457/.626/1.083) with eight doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 21 RBIs, 29 walks and 20 runs scored in 34 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks third in the IL in OPS, fourth in slugging percentage, fifth in on-base percentage, tied for eighth in walks, tied for ninth in home runs and tied for 13th in extra-base hits (18). After posting a 22.4 percent line drive rate and 30.6 percent pull rate with Triple-A Las Vegas in 323 plate appearances in 2023, Bride has compiled a 29.2 percent line drive rate (92nd in Triple-A).

WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 153 walks issued are the third-fewest in the International League entering play on Saturday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in eight of the last 13 games. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 23 out of 43 contests (53.4 percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Since at least 2005, Jacksonville has never lost nine-straight. games, in 2019 the club had two occassions losing eightstraight(4/16-4/23 & 4/29-5/7). With 15 losses in their last 16 games is the club's worst 16-game stretch since at least 2005.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first $14\,2/3$ innings without allowing

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

2024 SEASON 2023 SEASON -With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents

posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage (46.3 percent).
