LRST TIME OUT

Allentown, PA (June 4) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell 8-7 to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Sunday afternoon. After the RailRiders took 5-0 lead in the first, the IronPigs battled back and walked off the game in the bottom of the ninth.

The RailRiders brought the bats to put up five runs on five hits. Estevan Florial led off with a double and Elijah Dunham singled to reach. Andres Chaparro shot an RBI single drove in the first run of the contest. Franchy Cordero had a two-run scoring triple to get a 3-0 lead. Rodolfo Duran doubled home Cordero to get in scoring position. He moved over on a groundout and raced home when Jamie Westbrook was caught in a run down. The RailRiders led 5-0.

Lehigh Valley powered back with a four-run third. Scott Kingery and Weston Wilson both had base knocks to get aboard. An RBI double from Jake Cave got the team the board. Then Dustin Peterson shot a ball over the fence to clear the bases. His homer made it 5-4 SWB.

In the next frame, Jesus Bastidas got a run back for his team. Bastidas sent a ball 434-feet for his seventh homer of the season.

Westbrook scorched a solo shot in the sixth inning to give Scranton/Wilkes-Barre a 7-4 advantage.

The IronPigs cut into the lead with a home run off the bat of Dustin Peterson in the eighth to make it 7-5.

Lehigh Valley battled back in the ninth to walk the game off. Vimal Machin singled and Kingery doubled to put two in scoring position. After Cave walked, a sacrifice fly off the bat of Peterson tied the contest at seven apiece. Darick Hall singled to move Cave into scoring position. A RailRiders error trying to get Hall off first gave Cave the opportunity to sprint home. LHV took it in the bottom of the ninth 8-7.

Tanner Tully got the start allowing four runs in four and a third innings. The southpaw struck out five. Aaron McGarity finished the fifth getting two outs. Colten Brewer pitched a clean frame and recorded two outs in the seventh. Greg Weissert notched a strikeout to finish the inning. Deivi Garcia (L, 1-1) let up a solo shot in the eighth and two runs in the ninth.

Jake Jewell opened the contest for LHV but could only record two outs. He gave up five runs on five hits. Trey Cobb was on the mound for the final out of the frame. Christopher Sanchez took the next six innings of work holding the RailRiders to just two solo homers. Erich Uelman faced two batters in the eighth but left with injury. Jace Vines recorded the final two outs of the frame. Luis Ortiz (W, 1-0) tossed a clean ninth.

NEWS & NOTES

ON TOP THE ORG - Andres Chaparro has played in the most contests as a prospect in the farm system with 52 games for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre under his belt. Elijah Dunham has the next most with 49, while Jasson Dominguez has 46. Chaparro leads with runs batted in as well with 36 knocked home. Estevan Florial is tied with Aaron Palensky for the most home runs in the Yankees minor leagues with 12 apiece. On the pitching side Matt Bowman and James Norwood have each made 20 appearances this summer. Mitch Spence leads the way in innings pitched with 57.0 frames. Greg Weissert has five saves, the most of any reliever in the farm.

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE LEADERS - Among qualified players in the International League, Tanner Tully has the seventh lowest ERA with a 3.93 in eleven starts. Mitch Spence has tossed the fifth most innings as a starter with 57.0 thrown in eleven outings. Despite making one start in the Majors, Randy Vasquez's 55 strikeouts rank him tied for eighth.

VERSUS LEFTIES - The RailRiders have faced quite a number of lefty starters in the past few weeks. As a team, the group bats .268 against southpaws. Oswald Peraza has been hitting the best in this situation with a .340 average, seven home runs, and ten runs batted in. Estevan Florial bats .284 versus lefties with five homers and 13 RBIs.

JUNE BLUES - SWB is 0-4 in the month of June after finishing May with a 17-9 winning record. Four straight losses is the longest negative streak of the season, but the team looks to turn it around at PNC Field.

HOMER HEAVEN - The team is now tied for first homers hit in all of Triple-A baseball with Las Vegas who have both hit 97 this summer. Norfolk has 85 as a team. SWB is also first in long balls in all of Minor League Baseball and tied for third in all of baseball. Tampa Bay leads the way with 103 in 61 games. The New York Yankees have totalled 95. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. SWB homered 20 times against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twelve.

WHO'S ON FIRST - The RailRiders have had six different first basemen this season. Billy McKinney leads the way with 23 starts, while Andres Chaparro has made 17 starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Rodolfo Duran has made just two professional starts in the corner infield position. Carlos Narvaez, in just his third Triple-A contest, got his initial start at first. He's now played there three times.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has four birthdays in June. Oswald Peraza turns 23 on June 15 while the following day Will Warren turns 24. On the 18th of the month, Jamie Westbrook turns 28 and finally Michael Feliz turns 30 on June 28.

ATOP THE YANKEES FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12) and Sean Boyle (#28) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: MLB Pipeline - NYY No. 20; Fangraphs - NYY No. 21; Baseball America - NYY No. 12

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched a Sunday Day game, Took game one of the doubleheader...tossed longest outing of career with 7.0 IP on 5/9 vs OMA

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.
- Born in Kirkland, WA, claims Cary, NC as his hometown.
- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.
