## RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (33-22)

## Modesto Nuts (28-27)

RHP Chris Campos (5-3, 5.90 ERA) vs. RHP Tyler Cleveland (3-4, 5.96 ERA)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue their longest northern road trip of the year with 12 straight games. Tonight is game five of a six-game set against the Modesto Nuts (Mariners) here at John Thurman Field. From here, the Quakes will head to San Jose next week for their one and only visit to Excite Ballpark. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 20 to take on the Lake Elsinore Storm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE NUTS:** Today's game is the fifth of nine between the two clubs this year and the fifth of six at John Thurman Field. Last year, the Quakes went 3-3 here at John Thurman Field and 5-7 overall against the Nuts.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes failed to pull off a second straight ninth-inning rally, as they fell short at John Thurman Field on Friday night, dropping a 6-4 decision to the Nuts. Modesto starter Marcelo Perez (1-0) was brilliant, allowing just one hit and one walk over six scoreless innings. Rancho starter Jared Karros (1-1) struggled in his toughest outing of the year, as he allowed three runs on five hits over three innings, suffering his first professional loss. Dayton Dooney slugged his first homer as a Quake, a two-run shot in the eighth. Rancho put two on the board in the ninth, but left the tying run at the plate. The loss is Rancho's fifth in their last six games and gives Modesto three of four in the series.

**OFFENSE STILL ADJUSTING:** Thursday's six-run ninth was huge for a struggling offense, as the Quakes ended a season-worst four-game losing streak with the win. To put it in perspective, the six runs were as many as they had scored in the entire four-game skid (1,1,3,1). The 11-hit attack on Thursday was the first time the Quakes have been in double-digits since May 27, which was prior to Chris Newell's promotion. Friday night's five-hit performance was a return to the last week's struggles. They did hit their first home run in five games, with Dayton Dooney's first round-tripper of the year. That now gives them 52 home runs in 55 games, still tops in the league. Their .248 average is still fourth in the league.

**RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes activated RHP Payton Martin from the Development List on Thursday, as he gave the team three scoreless innings in his return to the starting rotation. Martin took the roster spot of RHP Jeisson Cabrera, who was placed on the Injured List.

**MAGIC NUMBER TALK:** With all four teams in the South Division losing on Friday, the Quakes still have a 4.5 game lead over Lake Elsinore with 11 to play in the first half, giving the Quakes a magic number of seven against the Storm and a magic number of six against Inland Empire. Despite losing seven of their last ten, that lead of 4.5 games is just one game off of the high-water mark, as the Rancho lead over Lake Elsinore has fluctuated between 5.5 and 2.5 over the last three weeks. Remaining games for the Quakes include two at Modesto, six at North-leading San Jose, then home for three games against the Storm to finish the first half. Lake Elsinore's remaining games include two at Fresno, Stockton at home for six, then three at Rancho. Inland Empire is now just one game back of Lake Elsinore, 5.5 games back of Rancho. The 66ers have two at home vs. Stockton, six at Fresno and then three vs. Visalia.

**CHRIS CAMPOS:** Right-hander Chris Campos makes his fifth start of the year for Rancho and his 12th overall appearance, his first against Modesto. Campos has dropped three consecutive decisions, allowing 13 runs (12 earned) on 12 hits and five walks in just 6.1 innings combined. In his last start, he suffered the defeat against Inland Empire, allowing two runs on two hits (both home runs) over just two innings on June 4. Campos was drafted by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of St. Mary's University.

**TYLER CLEVELAND:** Righty Tyler Cleveland makes his 11th appearance and seventh start of the year, his first against Rancho. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs on seven hits over three relief innings in a loss at Stockton on June 3. Cleveland was a 14th-round choice of Seattle in the 2022 draft from the University of Central Arkansas.
