STARTING PITCHING HELPS EARN DH SPLIT

Shaun Anderson tossed 6.0 shutout innings on Wednesday to help Jacksonville win the doubleheader finale 1-0 over Norfolk after falling 6-5 in the opener. The Jumbo Shrimp busted out to a 5-0 lead after two innings in the opening contest. However, **Kyle Stowers** hit a three-run home run in the sixth and **Nick Maton's** three-run shot in the seventh walked it off for the Tides. Anderson outdueled **Tucker Davidson** in the finale, with the lone run coming in the fourth inning on an RBI single by **Griffin Conine. Emmanuel Ramírez** picked up his 10th save.

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.4 percent of the club's innings, a total of 436.0 out of 849.0 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters also lead the level in ERA (4.25; next-closest is Memphis at 4.47) while ranking second in WHIP (1.35), fourth in BAA (.252), fifth in OPSA (.768) and ninth in walks (170).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 22-15 (.595) in their last 37 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 26 of those 37 affairs (70.3 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in both fewest runs allowed (135; next-closest is Indianapolis at 151) and ERA (3.43; next-closest is Indianapolis at 3.89) while ranking second in WHIP (1.33) and OPS against (.727) and fourth in both BAA (.240) and fewest hits allowed (288).

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** has been stellar since early May. Over his last 61 games, the Duke product is 63-for-215, slashing .293/.361/.558/.919 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 41 RBIs, 22 walks and 37 runs scored. Among the 111 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks eighth in HR/FB (26.6 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for 13th in the IL in both home runs (17) and extra-base hits (36), 18th in SLG (.503), 20th in hits (82), 21st in slugging (.502) and tied for 23rd in doubles (18).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 32 of the last 36 games, with 25 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 13 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 66 runs, 59 earned, on 144 hits (8.3 H/9) in 157.0 innings for a 3.38 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 159 strikeouts (9.1 K/9) against 68 walks (3.9 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 15 different pitchers over these 36 contests.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, **Troy Johnston**, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 48 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 60-for-176, slashing .341/.413/.528/.941 with 12 doubles, three triples, five homers, 24 RBIs, 20 walks and 33 runs scored. Johnston has 15 multi-hit games in his last 29 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (107) while also ranking tied for fourth in doubles (24) and 19th in batting average (.288).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 55 of his last 64 games, notching 23 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 80-for-250 (.320/.385/.488/.873) with 18 doubles, three triples, six home runs, 39 RBIs, 28 walks and 33 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks ninth in batting average (.298), 13th in hits (86) and tied for 13th in doubles (20).

SHRIMP BITES

Over his last four starts, **Max Meyer** is 1-0 with a 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 18 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 6 BB, 23 K, .247 BAA). He has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last 11 starts... The Jumbo Shrimp are 16-10 (.615) in their last 26 road games... Eight of Jacksonville's last nine games have been decided by two runs or fewer.

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
