Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at home against the Harrisburg Senators. It is the fifth of 12 matchups between the teams this season; one series in Reading and another series in Harrisburg from Aug. 22-27. In 2022, the Fightin Phils went 4-8 against the Senators, including dropping five-of-six games at home in April and split the six-game series in Harrisburg in August.

Comeback Kids

The Fightin Phils put the exclamation on a comeback when Max McDowell blasted a three-run home run to give Reading the 10-9 win last night. Reading fell behind 6-0 in the fifth when Mick Abel was chased from the game. Abel did register a season-high nine strikeouts. A home run from Oliver Dunn and double from McCarthy Tatum helped lead to the comeback victory. It was Reading's first win this season when trailing after six (0-16), seven (0-21) or eight innings (0-18).

No Donuts for the Fightins

Through 42 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-11 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching has also not yet thrown a shutout this season either.

A Look at the Bullpen

In wins, Reading's bullpen has been flat-out dominant, posting a 2.58 ERA over the Fightin Phils' 16 wins. In Reading's 26 defeats this season, the bullpen has posted a 7.56 ERA. In innings 1-5 of games, Reading has a +14 run differential, but is -33 in innings 6-9 of contests. But, last night Reading flipped the script, with a -6 run differential in innings 1-5 and +7 in the final four frames.

Fightins' Streaks

After a walk on a pitch-clock violation, Nick Podkul (.320) has now reached base in 14-straight games, which is tied for Oliver Dunn for the most this season. Carlos De La Cruz has reached in a season-high 13 games and McCarthy Tatum (.429) isn't far behing with eight games. Reading has also hit home runs in six-straight games, which is a season-long streak of long balls as well.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies picked up a 6-4 win at Atlanta last night to even this week's series. Craig Kimbrel notched his 400th career save, becoming just the eighth big league to accomplish the feat. Lehigh Valley got back to .500 at 24-24 with a 7-3 win over Buffalo. Jersey Shore fell to Aberdeen 6-1, while Clearwater was rained out at St. Lucie last night.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 27, 2016: At New Hampshire, Reading scores 3 in the 9th on Aaron Brown's first Double-A home run to tie it, then wins 9-8 in 13 innings. Rhys Hoskins hits a solo HR in the 13th for the winning run. Brown finishes 3-for-5 with 3 RBIs and a pair of runs.

Coming from the Capital

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Harrisburg, The Senators sit in second place in the Eastern League Southwest standings at 22-20 on the season. Last week, the Senators split a six-game series at home against Erie, winning the last two games like the R-Phils. Next week, Harrisburg stays on the road for a six-game series at Bowie.

On the Hill for Harrisburg

Lefty Mitchell Parker gets the start for Harrisburg tonight. He is 3-3 with a 7.03 ERA over eight starts. Parker has 36 strikeouts and 26 walks allowed over 32 innings pitched. He allowed two-earned runs on seven hits in five innings against Erie last Sunday. Parker spent all of 2022 with Wilmington, going 6-4 with a 2.88 ERA over 24 starts. He was a fifth round pick in 2020 out of San Jacinto Junior College.
