FISHER CATS COME BACK IN STYLE IN GAME ONE, DROP GAME TWO TO SPLIT

DOUBLEHEADER: The Fisher Cats, playing in just their second double-header of the season, halted league leading Somerset's seven-game win streak in game one, winning 10-8. New Hampshire utilized a two-run top of the seventh before eventually pushing across the winning run in the top of the eleventh. In game two, the 'Cats only recorded two hits, falling in a 2-1 decision.

COMING BACK LIKE JORDAN: Blue Jays number three overall prospect Jordan Groshans hit a home run in his first at bat back in the lineup, going two for five on the afternoon with two runs batting in and two hits.

THE STREAKS: Otto López's hit streak fell in game two after 17 games. This streak is the third-longest streak in Fisher Cats history. The hit streak started in the second game of the doubleheader vs. Portland on May 6th, and ended in the second game of the doubleheader vs. Somerset last night. He went 28-79 (.354) with 10 doubles and nine RBI.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 28, 2018---The Fisher Cats made it four out of five against the Hartford Yard Goats with a 5-2 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Jonathan Davis had first inning RBI singles. Juan Kelly knocked in a pair with double in the fourth to make it 4-0. T. J. Zeuch cruised to the victory, allowing just two earned runs in 6.2 innings.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Buffalo dropped both games of their doubleheader including the resumption of their game which had been postponed from Wednesday night. Dunedin fell to Tampa 10-7, falling to 7-15 on the season. Vancouver walked off Everett, winning 5-4 on a Spencer Horwitz single in the ninth. The Blue Jays split their double-header with the Yankees, riding an Alek Manoah gem to a shutout victory in game one before falling in game two.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will close out the season series this week against Somerset, before returning home for their first look at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets).

ROSTER MOVES: **May 27:** Outfielder Brock Lundquist activated from IL and catcher Rodrigo Vigil placed on development list. **May 25:** Reliever Curtis Taylor transferred from Triple-A Buffalo and relievers Mike Ellenbest and Cre Finrock reinstated from injured list. RHP Troy Miller transferred from High-A Vancouver and will make his first start tonight. RHP Simeon Woods Richardson placed on the Temporary Inactive List (at US Olympic Qualifying Camp).

ON THE HILL: Zach Logue can become the first Fisher Cats pitcher to pick up a third win of the season, as the crafty lefty will take the mound tonight. The former Kentucky Wildcat is holding opposing hitters to under .200. Opposite Logue, Shawn Semple gets the start for Somerset. Semple gave up nine hits and five runs in a loss to New Hampshire back on May 16th.

LAST TIME OUT: Became the first pitcher to have a quality start when he went six innings, allowing just one run, last Friday night at home vs. Portland. Logue struck out six. He improved to 2-0 in New Hampshire's 12-4 win.

v. SOMERSET: Makes his 2nd start against the Patriots. On Saturday, May 15 at Delta Dental Stadium, Logue worked 5.2 innings, allowing two runs. He struck out eight in the game. Somerset did not score in the first five innings against Logue, but an infield single, a double (Pita), and another infield single put the Patriots up 2-1.

2019: Made first Double-A start with Fisher Cats at Delta Dental Stadium on April 6 vs. Binghamton. Did not figure in decision, but allowed one run (unearned) on two hits over 6.0 IP.
