Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound tonight, looking to run the win streak to 3G for the first time since a 5G streak from 3/28-4/2. Toledo will counter with RHP **Dylan File**. Columbus is 14-6 (.700) versus right handers this year. File has faced Columbus three times in his career ('21-22 with Nashville, including Triple-A debut), going 1-1 with a 3.52ERA (15.1IP, 15H, 6R, 6ER, 6BB, 16K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus was 10-11 opposing Toledo last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022), including a 4-5 mark at Huntington Park (lost each of last 4G). Individually, **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .351 (13x37) with 2HR and 6RBI against the Mud Hens in his career (10G), while **Nolan Jones** has hit 4HR and collected 14RBI in 31G. **Juan Brito** has 2HR and 15RBI in 23G.

Deficit Shmeficit

Last night's win was the 12th comeback win for the Clippers this season, three more than any other team in the IL. Nearly half (5) of those wins have seen Columbus overcome a deficit of at least three runs (two more than the rest of the IL). The Clippers have played only 3G this season in which they have not trailed (2nd fewest in the IL) with two of those wins coming last week in Buffalo.

Walters Rehab

Andrew Walters (right lat surgery) is entering the fourth week of his rehab assignment, having pitched twice a week so far (only Tuesdays and Fridays). He has maxed out at 30 pitches to this point (4/21 at Buffalo), averaging almost 19 per outing. Walters has struck out half of his batters faced (12 of 24), boosting his rate to 37% in his Clipper career (holding hitters to a .169 average, 29x172).

On a Roll

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .351/.500/.757 with 8XBH in his last 11G (1XBH in first 12G). Of three Clippers with at least 20BB this season (rest of IL has 11 such batters), Watson is the only remaining member, as **Travis Bazzana** (most walks, 50, since IL debut on 8/12/25) was promoted to the Majors yesterday (**Cooper Ingle** has been injured since 4/24).

Familiar Surroundings

Juan Brito is slotting into the second spot in the batting order tonight for the 159th time in his Clipper career (73G and 332PA more than any other player in the IL since his Triple-A debut on 9/19/23). Brito doubled five times in his season-opening stint with Columbus, giving him 52 in his 182G IL career (only 12 batters have 50+ since his debut, all with 220+ games). He has 25 doubles in Huntington Park.

Buffalo Blues

Kody Huff is 6x12 with a HR and 2RBI in the last 3G after starting the Buffalo series 0x15 (closed the Iowa series 5x13 with 2HR and 7RBI). He is already sitting at 5HR this year, just a pair off his career best (2024 with Akron) and one behind last season with Columbus (1HR in first 28G last year). All 5HR have come with the Clippers trailing (one go-ahead), as they are 1-4 when he goes yard.

Opposite Weeks

Milan Tolentino was named IL Batter of the Week last time he was in Columbus (4/14-4/19), hitting .500/.545/1.250 with 4HR and 10RBI in 6G vs. Iowa, but followed up with a hitless series in Buffalo (13AB). At home, Tolentino is hitting .410 (16x39) with an .897SLG (4HR) over 13G this year (.152, 7x46, 2HR, .304SLG on the road). He owns a .925OPS in Huntington Park in his career (.654 on the road).

Wheels

Dom Nunez picked up his second steal of the season last night, as he is now 11 for 13 in his Triple-A career (since 2019; had 46SB and 30CS at lower levels, 2013-18). Nunez has consecutive multi-hit games (4x8) after having gone 4x35 (.114) in his first 12G and, since 4/22, he has drawn 7BB in 26PA (27%; 2BB in first 29PA, 7%). He owns a .330OBP all-time with Columbus, despite hitting .188.

Bottoms Up

Over the last 4G (3-1), the quartet of **Dayan Frias**, **Juan Benjamin**, **Maick Collado** and **Kevin Rivas** have combined to slash .298/.340/.489 with 2HR (both Benjamin) and 8RBI from spots 7-9 in the order (scored nine times). Prior to 4/9, only Frias had played at the Triple-A level (56G), while Benjamin had 1G in Double-A (4/4), with Collado (188G) and Rivas (50G) maxing out in Advanced-A.

This Date in Clipper History

4/29/1999

After a 4-run 9th for Columbus sent the game into extra innings, **Brian Raabe** sealed a Clippers' win with a walk-off, 3-run HR in the 10th. **Kurt Bierek** contributed a HR and 3RBI to the 10-7 victory, while **Jay Tessmer** threw a perfect inning for the win. Raabe (2B) and Tessmer (RP) would go on to be All-Stars in 1999 and Bierek was named the IL Rookie of the Year on his way to setting a franchise record for doubles (42).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,418 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 38-37 (.507) in pitch reviews, with batters going 24-27 (.471) and pitchers/catchers going 14-10 (.583). They have run out of challenges in 15G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-35 when playing past regulation (.593, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 86G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 13th in the IL this year (.976), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 16G this season (9-7, .563), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 401-419 (.489), 371-373 with Columbus (.499).
