### MISSIONS SNAP RIDERS THREE-GAME WIN STREAK, BEAT FRISCO 9-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the San Antonio Missions 9-3 on Saturday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (27-23, 71-48) snagged an early lead in the bottom of the second inning against San Antonio (23-26, 54-63) starter Austin Krob (4-10). Josh Hatcher singled to open the inning, advancing to second on a fielding error on the center fielder. He later scored on a balk, giving the Riders a 1-0 lead. In the top of the third inning, the Missions took the lead on a three-run homer by Cole Cummings to make it a 3-1 lead for San Antonio. The homer marked just the fourth allowed by **Emiliano Teodo** (5-4) in 19 starts with the RoughRiders. Teodo finished after 3.0 innings, allowing three runs on three hits and four walks while striking out three. **Josh Sborz**, on his second rehab assignment with the RoughRiders this season, took over in the fourth. The righty picked up the first out but allowed three runs on one hit, a walk, and a hit by pitch before exiting the game. Cummings highlighted the four-run frame with a two-run double off **Bryan Ch**i and later scored the final run of the inning to give the Missions a 7-1 advantage. In the top of the sixth, Chi struck out the first batter he faced. He was charged with one earned run on three hits and two walks across 2.0 innings. San Antonio notched one run on no hits and stranded the bases loaded against **Seth Clark**. The lefty issued two walks and hit two batters with Ripken Reyes driving in a run on a bases loaded hit-by-pitch, pushing the San Antonio lead to 8-1. In the home half of the seventh inning, **Cody** Freeman reached on an error and later scored on an RBI single by Aaron Zavala. Leading 8-2 in the top of the eighth inning, Joshua Mears belted his second homer in as many days. The solo shot chased Clark from the game and made it a 9-2 lead for the Missions. **Ricky DeVito** entered in the eighth and allowed just one hit across 1.2 shutout innings in which he fanned three. **Maximo Acosta** led off the bottom of the ninth inning with a double to left before scoring on a two-out RBI single by Cooper Johnson.

#### MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the fourth and final time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 60-29 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 34-9 at the Wolff. In the 23 games this season, in which they are 19-4, they have a 2.93 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 118-77. Aaron Zavala has driven in 15 runs over his 20 games against the Missions, while Cooper Johnson has hit 5 home runs in 12 games, batting .324/.444/.730/1.174.

#### **REHAB CITY**:

After Jacob deGrom made his first rehab start for the RoughRiders on Thursday, that put Frisco at eight rehabbers this season. The hitters include Josh Jung and Nathaniel Lowe while Cody Bradford, Dane Dunning, Josh Sborz, Jacob Latz and Tyler Mahle make up the pitchers. In 2018, the RoughRiders had 12 rehabbers, the most in franchise history. This season marks the highest volume of rehabbers since 2018.

### PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strenghth this season, but they have struggled over their last 11 games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .305 (123-for-403) with 24 doubles, eight home runs and averaging 6.4 runs per game on the offensive side, taking seven of 11 games. Frisco's bullpen had a 7.61 ERA (42ER/49.2 IP) and has allowed 69 hits over 49.2 innings while blowing leads in five of their seven losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 6-11 in their last 17 games.

### HOMER HAPPY:

Last Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 11 home runs in the last eight games, with those 11 home runs being third in the Texas League this week (Amarillo, 17). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 87 across their 119 games (on pace for 101, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

#### RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 29 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .737 OPS, second with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.5 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .213 (57-for-268) with runners in scoring position over their last 29 games.

#### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 39-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +66 run differential, a 4.14 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit nine of his 10 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .304/.400/.516/.916 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best re-cord in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
