**SPRINGDALE, AR** – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell behind early to the Frisco RoughRiders and could not come back, dropping Friday's game 11-6, as the series evened with two wins each.

- After Frisco struck in the first with an RBI double, Naturals right fielder **Tyler Gentry** responded in the bottom of the inning with an RBI double of his own to score Luca Tresh and tie the game at 1-1.
- The RoughRiders leapt ahead in the second with five runs against Naturals starter **Alec Marsh**, who surrendered six runs on seven hits with four strikeouts over four innings.
- After Marsh kept Frisco scoreless in the third and fourth innings, Northwest Arkansas added two runs in the bottom of the fifth, on a two-run homer from **John Rave**, the left fielder's 14th this season with the Naturals.
- Charlie Neuweiler** cruised through a 1-2-3 fifth inning, but after the Naturals brought the game within three runs, ran into trouble in the sixth and was tagged for five runs, with the RoughRiders jumping out to an 11-3 lead.
- Kasey Kalich** and **C.J. Eldred** combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief behind Neuweiler, giving the Naturals an opportunity to get back in the game.
- Seuly Matias** capped a string of four singles in the seventh inning to plate two runs, then **Gavin Stupiensi** singled in a run in the bottom of the ninth to keep the game alive, but the comeback fell short, in five-run defeat.
- Tresh and Rave each collected three hits in the game, while Tresh scored three times and Rave scored twice. As a team, Northwest Arkansas had 12 hits, while drawing two walks.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALES HISTORY

**The Naturals are 0-1 all-time when playing on September 17 in the regular season**  
On September 17, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Midland RockHounds 2-1 at Citibank Ballpark in Midland take a 2-1 lead in the 2010 Texas League Championship Series. The first five innings of the game were scoreless, then Midland took the lead with a run in the sixth. With two outs and **Derrick Robinson** on first base in the top of the eighth inning, **Eric Hosmer**'s sixth home run of the postseason ended up being the game-winner to give the Naturals a 2-1 series lead. Starter **John Lamb** twirled 6.2 innings of one-run baseball with five strikeouts in a no-decision effort.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 15 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
3 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means and John Rave.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 40-11, while when scoring six runs or less, just 17-68.
The Naturals are 39-17 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 18-51.
The Naturals are 51-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 6-64 when out-hit by their opponent.
When the Naturals score first, they are 36-25, whereas 21-52 when the opponent scores first ... the team that scores first in through 135 Naturals games is 88-47 (.652 winning percentage).

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 7-20 in one-run games this season, meaning 20 of their 78 losses (25.64%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 24 losses this season (including 15 of their one-run losses).

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 135 games, the Naturals have stolen 176 bases in 220 attempts (average 1.30 steals/game, 80.00% success rate).

- 176 steals leads the Texas League, ranks tied fifth in Double-A and tied 23rd in the Minors.
The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 90 of 135 games this season (66.67%) including a season-high stretch of 11 straight games from August 28 to September 9 ... and 45 games this season with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 20 times, meaning 40 of 176 steals this year (22.72%) have come on a double-steal.
Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 17 times, SIX of those occasions being Maikel Garcia ... Tucker Bradley had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
Maikel Garcia's 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks sixth in the Texas League, Nick Loftin's 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks tied 10th in the league.

RELIEF AID IN SEPTEMBER

Despite struggles for the Naturals' bullpen in much of 2022, September has been much kinder to the relievers, as the bullpen has a 4.38 ERA (25 ER in 51.1 IP) this month, topping the previous best single-month ERA of 4.64 in May.

- Walter Pennington (4.0 innings), Stephen Woods Jr. (3.1 innings) have not allowed a run this month, while Will Klein (5.0 innings) has allowed just one earned run, and Christian Chamberlain (5.0 innings) and Kasey Kalich (3.1 innings) have allowed two earned runs this month
Woods Jr. has been dominant since the start of July, with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP) over 17 appearances, the lowest ERA in that span among Naturals pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched OR seven appearances.

FALL STARS

Yesterday, the rosters for the 2022 Arizona Fall League were announced, with six Naturals players among Kansas City's seven representatives.

- Outfielders Tyler Gentry and John Rave will suit up for the Surprise Saguaros this fall, as well as right-handed pitcher Jonah Dipoto, and left-handed pitchers T.J. Sikkema, Walter Pennington and Christian Chamberlain.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder Tyler Gentry has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 13TH in batting average (.322) and 14TH in OPS (.958) when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.322), slugging percentage (.540) and OPS (.958), while he ranks second in on-base percentage (.418) behind Logan Porter's .444 ... his 85 runs batted in between the River Bandits and Naturals are the most in the system, while 128 hits, 21 home runs and 215 total bases all rank second.
Gentry has reached base in 63 of 72 games (87.50%) ... he has hits in 49 of his 72 games with the Naturals, with already 27 multi-hit games.
Since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .315 (85-for-270) with 16 doubles, 16 home runs and 62 runs batted in, with a .963 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 35 of 72 games, with 15 multi-RBI games.
Since he arrived in the Texas League, Gentry has driven in the second-most runs (62), has the second-most total bases (147), is third in slugging percentage (.552) and OPS (.963), tied third in runs scored (57), fourth in on-base percentage (.411), hits (85) and home runs (16) and seventh in batting average (.315).
Gentry has compiled the two of the longest on-base streaks among Naturals hitters this season, including a 28-game stretch that ended Sunday, the second-longest on-base streak in franchise history ... between July 30 and September 4, he hit .356 (36-for-101) with 10 extra-base hits and 20 walks, for a .485 on-base percentage over the last 28 games ... it is tied for the fifth-longest such streak in the Texas League this year ... he had hits in 21 of the 28 games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder CJ Alexander has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- When combining his number between the Naturals and Mississippi Braves (Double-A), he has a career-best 25 home runs and 85 runs batted in ... among all Double-A hitters this year, he ranks tied eighth in RBI and tied 10th in homers.
In 45 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .274 (49-for-180) with 19 extra-base hits (10 home runs) and 42 runs batted in, with 31 runs scored as well.
He has reached base in 34 of 45 games with the Naturals, with hits in 22 of the 45 games, 15 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 17 of 45 games, including already 12 multi-RBI games.
With four games left, Alexander is within reach of joining an exclusive group, the 20-20-20 club ... in 113 games this year, he has homered 25 times, stolen 19 bases and doubled 18 times ... one more steal and two more doubles would have him join the group of just 14 players in Minor League baseball this year with at least 20 home runs, doubles and steals ... even if he does not reach that milestone, he is currently one of just nine players with at least 25 home runs and 15 stolen bases.
Alexander was named the Naturals' August Player of the Month ... over 21 games in the month of August, Alexander hit .297 (27-for-91) with eight home runs and 29 runs batted in ... 29 RBI led the Texas League and all Double-A hitters last month, tied second among all full-season Minor League hitters ... 8 HR were tied for the league lead and tied third in Double-A.
In 32 games since the start of August, Alexander is hitting .299 (38-for-127) with 34 runs batted in with a .918 OPS (.343 OBP + .575 SLG).
C.J. began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (5)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
July 25 to July 31: LHP Dante Biasi ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 27 @ Wichita in an eventual 5-0 shutout win ... held the Wind Surge to just one hits and three walks while striking out five, on 79 pitches, his second straight scoreless start.
August 22 to August 28: RHP Jon Bowlan ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on August 28 vs. Springfield in an eventual 7-2 win ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and two walks while striking out two, his first scoreless start.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). - During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.
