LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox shut out the Binghamton Rumble Ponies for a second night in a row in a 3-0 victory on Thursday night. **Brandon Young, Ryan Hennen, Kyle Brnovich** and **Trey McGough** combined for a five-hit shutout. Young tossed 3.1 innings with seven strikeouts and Brnovich recorded six strikeouts over 4.2 innings to lead the way. Offensively, **Jud Fabian** smashed his team-leading seventh homer of the year to open the scoring and a two-run single in the ninth by **Collin Burns** added some insurance for Bowie. **Trey McGough** slammed the door to pick up his second save.

SHUT 'EM DOWN

The Baysox pitching staff has picked up three shutouts in the last seven games, including back-to-back shutouts each of the last two days against Binghamton. Bowie is one of just three Double-A squads to post back-to-back nine-inning shutouts this season. The staff's 1.98 ERA over the last seven games is third-best in all of MiLB.

JUD FLEXIN' ON 'EM

OF **Jud Fabian** blasted his league-leading fifth homer of the month of May last night to break the scoreless tie in the sixth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is slashing .295/.353/.659 with five homers and 11 RBI this month. The 23-year-old now has seven homers on the season, which leads the team and is tied for fourth in the league.

BOWENS BRINGS 'EM HOME

After driving in another run on Wednesday, 1B **TT Bowens** remains in the Eastern League's top-five in RBI with 23 on the season, good for fourth in the circuit. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is amongst the league leaders in several categories. The 25-year-old is sixth in slugging percentage (.526), fifth in OPS (.902), tied for fifth in extra base hits (13) and sixth in batting average (.309)

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After 5.2 more innings and six more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (168.1) and strikeouts (209). 18 of the 19 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Bowie's bullpen also has a 1.17 WHIP, which is tied for the third-lowest in all of Double-A.

SETH ON THE SLAB

RHP **Seth Johnson** makes his seventh start of the season. In his most recent start last Saturday against Akron, the Orioles No. 10 prospect went three innings, allowed two runs on two homers and two walks with three strikeouts to receive the loss. In his last road start, he struck out a season-high six batters over four innings in Richmond on April 28. Johnson is looking to get through five innings for the first time this season. This is the 25-year-old's first career start against Binghamton.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies own the best record in the Northeast Division at 18-13. Before their loss on Sunday, they had won a league-best eight in a row. The Rumble Ponies pitching has been a strong suit with the fourth-best ERA in the league (3.76). Eight of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Blade Tidwell (No. 10), RHP Brandon Sproat (RHP), OF Alex Ramirez (OF), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Joander Suarez (RHP), and OF Rhylan Thomas (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Luis Moreno makes his sixth appearance and his third start of the season. The 24-year-old has mostly been used this season in middle relief for the Rumble Ponies and sports a 5.11 ERA over 12.1 innings thrown. Moreno is in his second season with the Rumble Ponies after debuting with them last year where he threw the second-most innings on the team (119.1) and struck out the second-most batters (117) at an ERA of 4.98. The San Cristobal, Dominican Republic native signed as an international free agent in June 2019.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
