Penultimate Home Series

The Fightin Phils return home for their second-to-last home series of the season against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It's the 15th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and fourth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading leads the season-series 8-6.

Late Rally Falls Short

The Fightin Phils were unable to complete a comeback from down 6-0 in Thursday night's 6-4 loss to the FisherCats. New Hampshire struck first with a solo home run from RJ Schreck in the third inning. The Fisher Cats then added two runs in the fourth and the fifth each, chasing Christian McGowan from the game. New Hampshire then got another in the seventh to make it 6-0. Reading got one back in the bottom of the seventh thanks to a solo home run from Ethan Wilson, his fifth of the season. In the eighth Reading began to rally, getting a RBI single from Otto Kemp and a two-run hit from Trevor Schwecke. But, Jonathan Lavallee threw an immaculate inning in the bottom of the ninth to send Reading down in order to finish the game.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. extended his now season-best hitting streak to eight games with a hit in Thursday night's ballgame. Over his hitting streak, dating back to Aug. 7, Rincones is slashing .387/.441/.871, with a 1.312 OPS. He's added nine runs, three doubles, four home runs and nine RBI. Rincones is also up to 12 stolen bases on the season after two more on Thursday night, while also hitting nine home runs on the season, all over just 34 games. Rincones missed three months while injured. Over the course of a 138 game season, Rincones would be on pace for 37 home runs and 49 stolen bases if he kept up his current pace.

Good Week for Schwecke

Trevor Schwecke has turned in back-to-back strong performances against his former team in New Hampshire. He has turned in back-to-back multi-RBI performances. It is the first time this season that Schwecke has had multiple RBI on consecutive contests.

Streaks on Streaks

Otto Kemp extended his season-best on-base streak to 15 games with a hit on Thursday night. Over his streak, dating back to July 27, Kemp is slashing .309/.506/.473, with an .879 OPS. Carson Taylor also matched his season-best on-base streak at 13 games with a hit and walk on Thursday night. Taylor is slashing .326/.455/.512, with a .967 OPS over his streak, which dates back to July 30.

The Local Kid

Braeden Fausnaught fired five-strong innings in his Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He went five innings and allowed one run on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts. Fausnaught had tons of family and friends on hand for his debut on Wednesday. He played his high school baseball at Danville High School, which is 71 miles away from FirstEnergy Stadium. Fausnaught then played collegiately at West Chester University, which is just 45 miles from Baseballtown.

Fresh Prospect Rankings

MLB Pipeline released their latest prospect rankings on Tuesday night. In total, eight members of the Fightin Phils current roster were ranked amongst the Phillies' top-30 prospects: Andrew Painer (2), Justin Crawford (3), Gabriel Rincones Jr. (11), Jean Cabrera (13), Christian McGowan (22), Caleb Ricketts (24), Moises Chace (26) and Otto Kemp (26). Cabrera and Kemp are new to the top-30 after previously being unranked. Four former R-Phils were ranked as well: Mick Abel (6), Seth Johnson (15), Griff McGarry (21) and Carlos De La Cruz (25). The Philies had four players in MLB's top 100: Aidan Miller (29), Andrew Painter (34), Justin Crawford (58) and Starlyn Caba (91).

The Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in last place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are last in the Northeast Division with a 14-25 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently took two-of-five at home against Erie. Following this week, New Hampshire hosts Hartford. New Hampshire's roster features eight players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (9), Adam Macko (10), Eddinson Paulino (19), Dahian Santos (22), Yohendrick Pinango (23), Dasan Brown (25), RJ Schreck (29) and Josh Rivera (30).

Cat on the Bump

Righty Lazaro Estrada makes the start tonight for the Fisher Cats. It will be Estrada's seventh start at the Double-A level and he is 1-3, with a 2.93 ERA (30.2 IP, 24 H, 10 BB, 28 SO). He last pitched Aug. 10 against Erie, allowing two runs over five innings, with five strikeouts in a no-decision. Against Reading on July 27, Estrada suffered the loss, allowing three runs on two hits, with three strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched. Estrasa was called up from High-A Vancoucer onJuly 9, after posting a 1.96 ERA over nine starts with the Canadians. He also pitched in two games for Single-A Dunedin this year. Estrada spent all of last season with Dunedin. The 25-year old from Cuba signed with Toronto as an International Free agent in 2018.
