Tonight, Reading seeks its fourth win in five games on the road at the Hartford Yard Goats. It is the second series of the season between the teams and Reading's first repeat opponent. Hartford took 4/6 from the R-Phils in the first series at FirstEnergy Stadium from April 11-16. Hartford comes to Reading again from June 13-18 and the season series finishes in Hartford from August 1-6.

Not So "Good Man"

Last night, Reading was on the brink of victory, up by one in the bottom of the ninth, but Hunter Goodman blasted a two-run walk-off home run off Max Kuhns to give Hartford a 5-4 win. The Fightin Phils grabbed the lead in the eighth thanks to an Ethan Wilson RBI base hit. Tyler Phillips threw six-strong innings and Carlos De la Cruz curshed his fifth home run of the season in the first inning of the loss.

Rojas Reusrgence

After a hot start to the season, Johan Rojas cooled down, but that cold stretch has seemingly come to an end. Rojas has hits in his last six games, and reached base in his last eight. Both of those marks tie season-highs for Rojas. A reason could be Rojas' move from the leadoff spot to the three hole in the lineup. Since moving to the three hole on Apr. 29, Rojas is hitting .421 with 7 runs, while hitting .219 in the leadoff spot prior.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson's red-hot run continued last night with two more hits and two runs driven in. He had a double early in the game, then drove in the go-ahead run in the eighth. Since coming off the IL on .361 with four home runs and 13 RBI. He's also homered in back-to-back games in consecutive series.

Double Trouble

Reading turned a season-high three double plays last night, with the last being a 1-3 twin killing on a line drive that pitcher Tyler Phillips snared out of mid air. The three double plays puts Reading at 13 double plays which remains last in the Eastern League. But, the R-Phils have turned 10 double plays since Apr. 25, which leads the League over that time. After only tunning three over the season's first 15 games.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies were off yesterday and open a three-game series at home against the Boston Red Sox this weekend. Lehigh Valley picked up a win last night at Syracuse to get back to .500 at 14-14. Jersey Shore picked up a 7-5 win at Hickory, while Clearwater earned its 10th-straight win with a 3-2 walkoff over Lakeland. The win improved the Threshers to 18-6 on the season.

Hey Hartford

Last week, Hartford took four-of-five games on the road at New Hampshire, including four-straight win to finish the series. After this week, Hartford hits the road for seven games in six days at Binghamton, which includes a doubleheader on May 10, where Hartofrd will be home for one of the games, due to a postponement on April 23 in Hartford.
