**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the fifth of a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, with the two clubs having split the first four games of the series thanks to a Lugnuts victory last night. Lansing is now 7-9 against the Caps this year entering the final two meetings of the year. Lansing right-hander **Shohei Tomioka**, signed as an international free agent from Japan in 2020, makes his seventh start of the season, opposed by Lake County right-hander **Hunter Gaddis**, making his team-leading 14th start.

Last Night: Locos 5, Picantes 3. Jordan Díaz didn't start the game, but after being inserted in for Patrick McColl, he made an enormous impact with a game-tying solo home run and a tie-breaking three-run homer against Daniel Espino, lifting Lansing to victory.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains in a matinee tomorrow, returning home to host Dayton on August 20-25.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

## Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Going Yard: With yesterday's two Jordan Díaz homers, the Lugnuts have now hit 19 roundtrippers in 16 games against Lake County this year. In the last three games, the Nuts have scored 10 runs -- and nine of them have been scored via four home-run swings.

**Speaking of Díaz:** The young third baseman is tied for 3rd in the High-A Central with 20 doubles and tied for 4th with 32 extra-base hits. He is six days away from his 21st birthday.

Blue Rocks Report: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison. Guasch and Millas were each assigned to the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks (with Shuman yet to receive an assignment). Guasch made his Washington organizational debut yesterday, allowing three hits (all home runs) and five runs (two earned) in 4 2/3 innings, striking out five.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is second in the Majors in home runs (34), first in RBIs (85), third in on-base percentage (.412), third in slugging percentage (.633), first in OPS (1.044), first in total bases (248), and second in runs scored (84) behind 2017 Lugnuts teammate **Bo Bichette** (85). 2019 Lugnuts outfielder **Griffin Conine** leads the Minors with 29 home runs.

Man of Steal: 2021 Lugnuts shortstop Max Schuemann, now in Double-A Midland, is tied for 4th in all of Minor League Baseball with 41 stolen bases, two back of the MiLB leaders.

Nutlympics Report: Event 3, Juggling, was held before tonight's game, with Jared McDonald winning the gold medal, DJ Lee capturing silver and Yerdel Vargas taking bronze. Event 2, Grape Catching, was held on Wednesday, with the pairing of tosser Brock Whittlesey and catcher William Simoneit winning gold, followed by Leudeny Pineda/Elvis Peralta, Jr. taking silver, and Jorge Juan/José Mora earning bronze. Event 1, Fungo Golf, came last Sunday, opening the Nutlympics, with Anthony Phillips winning gold, Javier Godard silver and Charles Hall bronze.

**Future Lugnut Spotlight:** Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** moved into MLB.com's ranking as the No. 30 Athletics prospect after the deadline deals. A 6th-round selection from Westlake H.S. (Atlanta) in 2018, Butler is leading Low-A Stockton with in games (76), hits (72), runs (52), homers (15), total bases (142), RBIs (57) and walks (50), and looks well on his way to becoming a Lugnut before the year is out.

## **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2014:** Jeff Holm went 5-for-5 with two home runs, Wynton Bernard went 4-for-5, and the West Michigan Whitecaps piled up 18 hits in a 14-6 win in Lansing. Three Lansing pitchers gave up the 18 hits.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17, pitcher Conner Greene '15 and pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

**Star of Stars:** The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 15 different starting pitchers this season, specifically Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Niightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesev.

All-Time Roster History: Catcher Cooper Uhl became the newest Lugnut to debut on August 5, the 47th different player on the ballclub this season and the 851st Lugnuts player all-time.



**Talented Staff:** Shohei pitched on a talented Toyo University staff, evidenced by how the 2018 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft was loaded with his teammates, with Hiroshi Kaino selected 1st overall by Fukuoka, Taiga Kamichatani going later in the 1st round to Yokohama, and Chunichi drafting Kodai Umetsu in the 2nd round.

**The Road to MLB:** After not being drafted, Tomioka pitched for VITAL-NET in the amateur Industrial League, a level in which Hideo Nomo, Jun Tazawa and Kosuke Fukudome all first made their names before joining the higher ranks... tried out for the Athletics with 27 other pitchers in Autumn 2019, hit 95 mph with his fastball, and was signed in February... scout: Toshiyuki Tomitsuka...2021 marks his pro debut.

Starting Strong: After a successful pair of scoreless innings in his pro debut on Opening Night, May 4, following Seth Shuman, Tomioka was even sharper against Lake County in three scoreless innings on Saturday, May 8, after relieving top prospect Jeff Criswell... entered in the 3rd inning, working around a two-out double by Will Brennan... struck out two batters in a 1-2-3 4th... gave up a leadoff single in the 5th to Daniel Schneeman but erased him with a double-play ball and faced the minimum... of 10 batters faced, only Brennan and Schneeman hit the ball out of the infield... Lugnuts won, 2-0... in each of his first two outings as a professional, Tomioka received the victory from the official scorer.

Last Outing, August 1: Tomioka made his second start in a four-day span against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, lasting just 2 2/3 innings... after a scoreless 1st inning, he loaded the bases with none out in the 2nd before walking in a run and allowing an RBI fielder's choice... gave up a leadoff home run in the 3rd inning to Agustin Ruiz (on an 0-2 pitch) before setting down Tirso Ornelas and Justin Lopez and getting pulled in favor of Charlie Cerny... 57 pitches, 33 strikez.

**2021 vs. Captains:** Made two scoreless appearances in relief against Lake County, totaling five innings (May and May 8)... joined the Lugnuts rotation on July 15 against Lake County (4 IP, 0 IP), combining with Jack Cushing on a five-hit shutout... in all, has thrown nine scoreless innings vs. the Captains this year: five hits, one walk, six strikeouts.
