LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Sunday's series finale vs. Winston-Salem, 2-1, in 10 innings...Dash scored the winning run in the top of the 10th on a C Michael Turner sacrifice fly...DH Wilfred Veras started the scoring for Winston-Salem with an RBI single in the 1st...C Kevin Parada answered for Brooklyn with an RBI double in the home half... Parada finished with 2 hits and a walk...Veras and SS Andy Atwood added multi-hit games for the Dash...RHP Tyler Stuart tallied a career-high 7 innings, permitting 1 run with 6 strikeouts...RHP Dylan Tebrake hurled 2 perfect innings of relief.

NEW TO THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn made a bevy of roster moves prior to Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore...4 players have joined the Cyclones from Class-A St. Lucie: RHPs Benito García & Michael Krauza, as well as OFs Scott Ota & Eduardo Salazar...LHP Quinn Brodey & RHP Trey McLoughlin were transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while C Omar Narváez had his Major League rehab assignment transferred to Triple-A Syracuse on Monday...García makes his return to Brooklyn in 2023 after registering a 1.93 ERA (1 ER in 4.2 IP) in 2 early May appearances...Krauza tossed 1.0 scoreless inning for Brooklyn in 2022 and did not allow a run in 3 outings (3.1 IP) with St. Lucie in 2023... Ota was 3-for-11 (.273) in 3 games for the 'Clones in 2021 before missing the remainder of the year with injury...He was a .271 hitter (13-48) with a homer & 6 RBI in 17 games in the Florida State League this campaign... Salazar slashed .247/.307/.358 with a home run and 9 RBI in 26 contests for St. Lucie...McLoughlin (1.65) and Brodey (2.65) each had sub-3 ERA's in relief before their promotion to Double-A.

BIG STU: At 6-foot-9, RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023... The 23-year-old had his scoreless inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings on Sunday, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.13) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP Dustin Saenz (2.03)...Stuart is also 6th in the circuit in WHIP (1.15), tied for 8th in batting average against (2.13), and 9th in innings pitched (39.0)...The Kankakee, III. native is also 1st in LOB% (89.4%), 2nd in FIP (2.90), 3rd in xFIP (3.52), and 5th in strikeout rate (30.8%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

**THEY'RE NO. 1:** The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 11 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 15 earned runs (22 total) on 64 hits through the last 97.2 innings...That is good for a 1.38 ERA...That mark is almost a full run better than the 2nd-best mark in the SAL and High-A (Greenville, 2.27)...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Class-A Columbia is 2nd (1.86)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 37 (9.6 BB%) and struck out 118 in that span (30.5 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 50-22, over the 11-game stretch...Brooklyn is 8-3 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones have the only sub-4 ERA in the SAL with a league-best 3.84 mark.

BULL-PEN ON PARADE: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.26) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Wilmington (3.47) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.40) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and at the High-A level...The 3.26 ERA is 5th best in all of Minor League Baseball...RHP Paul Gervase (0.52), RHP Wilkin Ramos (2.08), and RHP Manny Rodriguez (2.66) have all mustered sub-3 ERA's in relief for the 'Clones (min 15.0 IP).

RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has faced only one batter over the minimum...In 4 appearances, Tebrake has not allowed a run and walked only 2 over 6.0 innings, registering 8 strikeouts.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** C **Kevin Parada** added another two-base hit on Sunday afternoon and is tied with Hudson Valley OF **Spencer Jones** for 2nd in the SAL in doubles (13)...Only Winston-Salem OF **Wilfred Veras** (19) has collected more...In May, Parada is also tied for 2nd in the circuit in two-baggers (9) and tied for 3rd in the league in extra-base hits (13).

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF Alex Ramírez has reached base safely in 10-straight games since May 18...In that time, the 20-year-old is slashing .303/.410/.515 with a .926 OPS...Ramírez has 4 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 6 walks in those contests...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (102), doubles (25), RBI (57), and total bases (153)...He only trails teammate OF Stanley Consuegra (36) in extra-base hits (34).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs Orion Kerkering (25) and RHP Tommy McCollum (29) are featured...INF Hao Yu Lee (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30... The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

GREAT SCOTT!: RHP Christian Scott punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory on Saturday vs. Winston-Salem...The Coconut Creek, Fla. native posted 5 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Hudson Valley, Scott has not yielded a run on 2 hits over 9 innings...The former Florida Gator has not walked a hitter and punched out 10...In 4 starts since returning to Brooklyn on May 5, Scott is 1-0 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER in 14.2 IP), 1 walk, 15 K's, and a WHIP of 0.82.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep has picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...The former Kentucky Wildcat had a 9-game hitting streak stretching back to May 14 at Wilmington snapped on Sunday...In his last 17 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .305/.359/.525 with a .885 OPS... Estep has accumulated 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, and 10 RBI in 64 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 135 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 14 of those 17 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 149 points in that time (.047 to .196).

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Tuesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (178), at-bats (586), plate appearances (700), runs scored (92), walks (94), and stolen bases (44)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) last Tuesday, added an RBI on Saturday, and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (188), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (110).

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 17 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 87 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (95), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (93), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (93) and Mariners' prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (88) have nabbed more...De Los Santos has also snagged 50 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 37...Omar is already 15 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

JEFF JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón matched his then-team-season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

LAST TIME OUT: Garnered his 2nd-straight victory last Tuesday night vs. Winston-Salem...Yielded 2 runs on 2 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 4 and struck out 7...Hurled 86 pitches and a season-high 55 strikes (64.0%)...Relieved by RHP Paul Gervase to start the top of the 6th with Brooklyn leading, 4-2...Cyclones went on to take the series opener, 7-3.

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by Baseball America...Only RHP Kodai Senga is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

**2022:** Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball. com and Perfect Game.

**LORETTO LIGHTNING:** Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 firstround pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP Ryan Weathers...Ryan's father, David, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
