FROM THE CROW'S NEST

<u>LEFT HANGING:</u> The Marauders' game on Sunday against Clearwater was suspended due to inclement weather, with the score tied, 4-4, entering the bottom of the ninth inning. The two teams are likely to resume the suspended contest— Bradenton's second of the season (June 8 vs Daytona)—when the Threshers return to LECOM Park August 17-22.

KING OF THE HILL: Tonight's starter, Luis Ortiz, has a 1.62 ERA over his last four outings (three starts). This includes his most recent start last Wednesday against Clearwater, when he struck out a career-high nine batters across six innings in his first quality start of the season

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez had a team-best eight-game hitting streak end in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader against Clearwater, but he has still hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .318 during that stretch. Rodriguez leads the team with 53 total hits and 15 multi-hit games, including a three-hit performance last Wednesday, which matched his season

WALK THIS WAY: With 31 walks drawn in the past series against Clearwater, the Marauders are now third in the Low-A Southeast with 338 walks, helping boost Bradenton's team OBP to .360 (third in the league). This comes despite facing a Clearwater pitching staff that has issued the second-fewest walks in the league.

AMONG THE BEST: The Marauders rank second in the Low-A Southeast in runs (339), home runs (54), and slugging percentage (.382). Bradenton's pitching staff also owns Minor League Baseball's fifth-highest strikeout total (660), behind only San Jose, Modesto, Fort Myers, and Somerset.

THE OPPONENT: The Marauders and Tortugas are facing off for their second and final head-to-head series of the season, having previously met June 8-13 at LECOM Park, a 4-games-to-2 series win for Bradenton. The Tortugas are coming off a series split at Jupiter, and previously took 5-of-6 against Lakeland at home.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: Hudson Head (#5), Eddy Yean (#12), Jared Jones (#16), Sammy Siani (#18), Nick Garcia (#20), Endy Rodriguez (#25), Alexander Mojica (#28), and Dariel Lopez (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

<u>UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:</u> New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +66 (Tampa is second in all of MiLB at +172, trailing only Everett's +179)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top five in home runs: Jase Bowen, Hudson Head, and Sammy Siani are tied for second in the league with 8 HR each; Endy Rodriguez is tied for third with 7 HR, and Alexander Mojica's 6 HR is tied for fourth... Sammy Siani is 10th in all of MiLB with 44 BB... Eli Wilson is third in the league with a .495 OBP... Enmanuel Mejia is tied for second in the league with six saves, trailing only Daytona's Vin Timpanelli (8)...
