ON THE BUMP: Brewers no. 13-rated prospect Logan Henderson will make his second start of the year and his first career appearance against the Braves Triple-A affiliate. The 23-year-old got his season started on Saturday night against Jacksonville where he allowed six hits and five earned runs. The six hits matched his single-game career-high which he has now allowed twice in his 45 career starts. His eight strikeouts from Saturday are the most by any of Nashville's starters so far this year and are third-most in the International League entering Thursday's game against the Stripers.

BE ERNEST(O): Ernesto Martinez Jr. got the Sounds into the hit column and was the only player to make his way on base into the top of the seventh inning. He collected the first hit of the game for Nashville when he roped a single into right field in the fifth and also drew a leadoff walk in the top of the second. Through the first five games of the year, Martinez Jr. is tied for the third-most hits on the club with three and is the owner of the only triple for Nashville in the early part of the season. Martinez Jr. was a non-roster invitee to Milwaukee Spring Training this year and appeared in 12 games, hitting .278 (5-for-18) with a double and home run. At 6'6" / 254 lbs., Martinez Jr. paced the Southern League with 30 doubles in 2024 and added 13 homers with 62 RBI and was 20-for-25 in stolen base attempts.

THE ARMBARN: Since allowing five earned in game two of the Jacksonville series, the Nashville bullpen has combined to allow one earned run in their last 13.1 IP. After Wednesday's game in Gwinnett, the Sounds bullpen boasts the third-best ERA in Triple-A at 2.31 and has allowed 13 hits in their 23.1 IP so far on the season with 26 strikeouts. After his inning on Wednesday, Brewers no. 19-ranked prospect Craig Yoho has 2.1 IP without a run. Vinny Nittoli and Ryan Middendorf have also both gone 2.0 IP without surrendering a run to lead the way for the Sounds bullpen.

BIG BAD WOLF: LHP Grant Wolfram made his second appearance on the mound this season, working two scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts and a walk on Wednesday. Wolfram is one of five players with Nashville that are on the Brewers 40-man roster. He made 55 appearances for Triple-A Round Rock in the Texas Rangers system from 2023-2024 and signed with the Brewers as a free agent on December 11, 2024, a day before his 28th birthday. Dating back to 2024, Wednesday marked his 33rd scoreless Triple-A appearance in his last 46 games. He allowed two earned on a hit in his Nashville debut on Saturday night against Jacksonville.

BOOTS WERE MADE FOR WALKIN: Anthony Seigler has drawn multiple walks in each of the last three games. His six walks are tied for fourth in the International League and T-6th in Triple-A entering action on Thursday. Nashville had six players draw a walk in six consecutive games during the 2024 season to lead the club for longest base on balls streak. This is the first time in Seigler's career that he has strung together three straight games with multiple walks. He had previously had drawn 2+ walks in back-to-back games seven times with his last coming on August 23-24, 2024. He posted a walk in nine straight games from May 11-26, 2023 for his longest streak of consecutive games with a free pass.

DEIVI'S DAY: In his second appearance (first start) with the Sounds after throwing an inning of relief on Opening Night against Jacksonville, RHP Deivi Garcia (0-1) suffered the loss after allowing three earned on four hits with four strikeouts and three walks. After serving as a reliever for the majority of 2024 with Triple-A Charlotte, Garcia made five straight starts to end the year last year, never going longer than 3.0 IP. Wednesday marked the 99th start of his minor league career but has now only made 14 starts since his time with Triple-A Scranton/WB in 2022.

DOUBLE DURBIN: Brewers no. 22-ranked prospect Caleb Durbin picked up his second double of the season on Tuesday against Gwinnett. He leads the team in doubles, TB (10), hits (5), AVG (.278), HR (1), SLG (.556), OPS (.834), and XBH (3)... His 10 total bases are twice as many as the next closest Nashville player and he is the only player with more than one XBH for the Sounds through the first five games.

WES IS MORE: Wes Clarke ended his two-game hitless streak to begin the season with a multi-hit performance on Tuesday. After going 0-for-8 in his two games played against Jacksonville over Opening Weekend, Clarke started his year 0-for-9 with a strikeout in his first plate appearance on Tuesday. He then proceeded to single in his next two plate appearances. Clarke ranked second in the Brewers farm system last year with 21 home runs and put together consecutive 20+ home run seasons in 2023-2024. He entered this year with 15 more home runs than anybody in the Brewers farm system over the past two seasons.

- Enters the 2025 season as the no. 13-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on August 9th and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th.
- 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
