NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 7-3, on Friday night at Mirabito Stadium. **Brandon Sproat** struck out a career-high 13 batters -- including 11-straight strikeouts to end his outing -- over five scoreless innings, while issuing just two hits and no walks. **Alex Ramirez** hit a two-run single & **Matt Rudick** had two hits.

ON BRAND FOR BRANDON: Mets No. 5 prospect and top pitching prospect, and MLB Pipeline's No. 94 overall prospect **Brandon Sproat** did something on Friday night that no Major League pitcher has ever done. Sproat struck out 11-straight batters in his start, finishing with a career-high 13 punch outs over five scoreless innings. MLB's record for consecutive strikeouts in one game is 10 -- Tom Seaver (April 22, 1970 vs. Padres), Aaron Nola (June 25, 2021 vs. NYM), and Corbin Burnes (August 11, 2021 @ CHC). Seaver's record stood for 51 years in the majors. The 2023 Mets' second-round pick is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball with a 2.05 ERA, across High-A and Double-A. He also ranks among MiLB's best with a .169 BAA (3rd) and a 0.94 WHIP (7th) and 110 strikeouts (T-18th). In 11 Double-A starts, Sproat is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA, 77 strikeouts in 62.1 innings a 0.87 WHIP, and opponents are hitting .181 against him.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 69 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** had a strong month of July. In 20 games in July, Clifford hit .291 with a .371 OBP, a .915 OPS, 23 hits, four home runs, eight doubles, 13 runs batted in, and 15 runs scored. Clifford recorded at least one hit in 15 of his 20 games in July. Clifford has driven in a run in each of the last two games and has 38 RBIs in 61 games at the Double-A level, averaging one RBI every 1.6 games. Since the start of June, Clifford's longest span without an RBI is six games.

RUDY: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** went 2-for-5 on Friday and recorded his team-leading 19th multi-hit game. Rudick is tied for the fourth-most doubles (21) and fifth-most walks (46) in the Eastern League. Over his last 19 games since July 5, Rudick is hitting .274 with one home run, seven doubles, six runs batted in, 12 runs scored, and nine walks.

NO DOUBT NOLAN: Right-hander **Nolan Clenney** earned his fifth win of the year on Thursday, with two strikeouts over 3.1 scoreless innings of three-hit ball out of the bullpen. Since he allowed a season-high seven runs at Reading on May 22, Clenney has been electric out of the bullpen. The 26-year-old is 3-1 with a 3.75 ERA and a 25-to-4 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 24 innings over his last 15 appearances in that span. Clenney has not allowed an earned run in seven of his last 15 outings. More recently, over his last 11 outings, Clenney is 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA and a 20-to-3 K-to-BB ratio in 18.1 IP.

JULY RECAP: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies went 13-9 (.590) in the month of July, which marked their best winning percentage in any month this season. It marked Binghamton's highest winning percentage by month since it went 16-9 (.640) in August 2021. The Ponies had a 10-game win streak from July 4 to July 19, which marked the franchise's longest win streak since 2006. Binghamton had the 2nd-most HR and 3rd-best ERA in the EL in July.

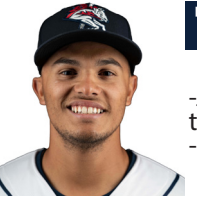
