Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, marking the second bullpen game of the season for Columbus (had only three bullpen games last season, one through first 114G). Indianapolis will counter with RHP **Noah Davis**. Columbus is 4-1 (.800) versus right handers this year. Davis has faced Columbus twice in his career, last season with St. Paul (2.1IP, 1H, 1R, 1ER, 1BB, 3K).

vs. the Indians

Columbus was 9-9 against Indianapolis last year, despite owning a +13 in run differential (12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 16-6 (.727) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five runs. Individually, **Travis Bazzana** has hit .310 (9x29) with 4HR (all HR in Triple-A career) and 8RBI against Indy in his career (8G).

Slow Starts

Through the first 5G, the Clippers have plated just eight runners across innings 1-6 (Tuesday's 4th is the only multi-run inning in first two thirds of the game). From the 7th on, they have pushed 14 runs in, while holding opponents scoreless (only team in the IL yet to allow a run). Columbus has been beaten to the punch in every game this year (Buffalo and Rochester are only other teams to not score first).

Second Look

Columbus lost both challenges on Sunday, but bounced back to go 4-2 this series (4-1 on Saturday and 5-2 on opening night). The 13-7 (.650) record put forth through 5G is a far cry from last year, in which the Clippers finished 19th in the IL (.431; had worst rate through most of the season before closing on a 28-23 run in the last 23G). **Travis Bazzana** (3-0) and **Cooper Ingale** (6-3) lead the way.

Always Halpin Out

Petey Halpin nailed two runners at the plate on Tuesday, giving him his first outfield assists of the year (14 in last 48G in the IL, dating to 7/22/25). Since the start of the 2025 season, his 21 outfield assists (128G) pace all of minor league baseball and are 10 clear of 2nd place in the IL. He is also riding a 117G errorless streak, dating to 4/11/25 (committed 10E and had 150FA in 196G of Double-A career).

Brito Ball

Juan Brito's double last night gives him 52 in his Columbus career, tied for 7th most in the IL since his debut on 9/19/23 (all other nine players with at least 50 doubles have played over 200G in that time, Brito has 178G). Brito has split exactly half his games between home and road (89), but has a lower batting average at home (.257 to .261) despite a better eye (+8 in BB/K at home; -30 on the road).

Big Dog

Nolan Jones has hit safely in 13 straight games with the Clippers, dating to 9/21/22, hitting .340 (17x50) with 5HR (.740SLG) and 13RBI over the stretch. Including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .330/.445/.667 with 20HR and 70RBI over his last 72G in Triple-A, having reached base in 66 of them (has 20 hitless games). He has also scored 67 times and gone perfect in steal attempts (5).

On the Upswing

After a slow start to his Triple-A career (.183/.299/.402 with 5HR and 11RBI in 25G), **Kahlil Watson** has hit safely in 20 of his last 23G, since 8/28/25 (.326, 28x86) while reaching base in each of his last 28G (.419OBP since 8/19/25). He has been active on the basepaths in that time, collecting 11SB (2CS) and scoring 19 runs. Last night's leadoff homer snapped a 31AB streak without an XBH (9/17/25).

East Coast Bias

Stuart Fairchild has 13HR in 65G of his International League career, against 13HR in 63G in the Pacific Coast League. His IL average is 10 points higher (.286 to .276) and while he is slugging worse in the IL, his .506SLG is 21% better than the average IL hitter since 2021 (.529SLG in the PCL was 17% better than average). He has hit safely in each of his last 8G in the IL (.414, 12x29 since 9/17/23).

Working on Another

Milan Tolentino swiped his second base of the season last night, to go along with 1HR (3/29 at Iowa). After becoming the first player in Clipper history to achieve a 20-20 season last year (21HR, 20SB), he is on pace for 30HR and 60SB. Last night marked his second game without a strikeout, as his current K-rate stands at 26% (34% last year; also posting a 26% BB-rate, compared to 12% last year).

This Date in Clipper History

4/2/2025

Columbus and St. Paul played to a scoreless tie through the first seven innings at Huntington Park before the Clippers dropped a pair in the 8th on the way to a 2-0 victory. **Parker Messick** began the game with 4.0IP and **Parker Mushinski** finished it with 2.0IP to collect the win. At the plate, **Juan Brito** was 2x4 and stole a base, while also scoring a run.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,406 to 1,346).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .580), including 26-16 at home (.619, have won 17 of last 27). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Christian Cairo moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 9/16/25 vs. Omaha and those men came around to score in the win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 83-21 (.798) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 14-6 (.700) mark last season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 390-407 (.489), 360-361 with Columbus (.499).
