KNIGHTS WIN SERIES FINALE ON WALK-OFF

The Jumbo Shrimp rallied from a 6-1 deficit on Sunday only to lose 9-7 on Caden Connor's walk-off three-run home run. After each team scored in the first, Dru Baker smashed a two-run shot in the second. Tim Elko added a threerun bomb in the fifth to make it 6-1. Jacksonville got five consecutive two-out base runners in the sixth to score three runs, and after a sacrifice fly in the seventh, Mark Coley II bashed a two-run homer to put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead 7-6. However, Charlotte got three straight two-out hits in the ninth, capped by Connor's walk-off.

AHOY, EIGHTY(-ONE)!

At 81-57 (.587), Jacksonville's 81 wins are tied with both Lehigh Valley and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the most in Triple-A. Those 81 triumphs are Jacksonville's most in a season since 2014, when they registered an 81-59 (.579) record. The last time a Jacksonville club won more than 81 games in a season was 2009, when the Suns went 82-58 (.586). Jacksonville's .587 winning percentage this season is their best since the 2006 Suns finished the campaign 86-54 (.614).

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

While the club has made 118 errors, the fifth-most in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense has helped the club yield the second-fewest hits and second-fewest runs in Triple-A this season. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .715. That figure would also rank ninth in MLB.

With a 27-14 (.659) record in one-run games, Jacksonville is two behind Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in Triple-A, and tied for fourth among the 120 MiLB teams. The 27 one-run triumphs are the most for the Jumbo Shrimp since they went 27-18 in one-run games during the 2021 campaign. The last time a Jacksonville club had more than 27 one-run wins in a season was 2014, when the Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp are 51-32 (.614) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 63.0 percent of their 81 victories have come by those slim margins.

SNELLING BEE

Over his last seven starts, Robby Snelling has struck out 62 against just nine walks in 43.2 innings, yielding only eight runs, six earned, on 31 hits for a 1.24 ERA. The 21-yearold has notched three starts with double-digit strikeouts. including a career-high 13 in game one of a doubleheader on September 3 at Charlotte - the most in a game for a Jumbo Shrimp pitcher since Jorge Guzmán fanned 13 Mississippi Braves on August 9, 2019. During that contest, Snelling also recorded Jacksonville's first complete game since Devin Smeltzer's seven-inning no-hitter on September 1, 2023 in the finale of a doubleheader against Charlotte. Over these last seven starts, Snelling has generated 106 whiffs on 314 swings, a rate 33.8 percent. For comparison, Dylan Cease leads MLB this season at 34.0 percent.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 281 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank ninth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 25 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 280, 10th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 281 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 18 of the 31 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 314 punchouts (10.1 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Twelve of the club's top 26 strikeout games this season have come in the last 31 games. The Jumbo Shrimp registered 17 strikeouts on September 6 at Charlotte, their most in a game since August 10, 2024, when they compiled 18 punchouts at Toledo.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville drew a season-high nine walks on Sunday against Charlotte... The Shrimp outscored Charlotte 36-29 and won four of seven in their set at the Knights. However, Charlotte outhit Jacksonville 59-48 over the seven contests.



ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was named the International League Pitcher of the Month for August after allowing just five runs (three earned) in 30.0 innings over five starts for a 0.90 ERA and 3-1 record. Among those five starts, he had two scoreless outings and struck out 38 against just nine walks. Opponents hit just .189 against Snelling.

-Snelling was promoted to Jacksonville on July 9 from Double-A Pensacola.

-At the time of his promotion, Snelling ranked tied for fourth in the Southern League in strikeouts (85), seventh in WHIP (1.22), 11th in ERA (3.61), 13th in batting average against (.238), tied for 13th in games started (14) and 14th in innings pitched (72.1).

2024 SEASON

-Snelling was transferred to Jacksonville on September 20 from Double-A Pensacola.

With both Double-A San Antonio and Pensacola, held opponents to a .254/.335/.457/.792 batting line in 257 plate appearances. With runners on, that swelled to .322/.376/.503/.879 in 223 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

-Earned Baseball America's Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

-Between three levels, Snelling went 11-3 this season with a 1.82 ERA. He struck out 118 and walked 34 in 103.2 innings. He allowed just four home runs in 22 starts. Since 2000, just seven teenage minor league pitchers have recorded a sub-2.00 ERA in 100 innings or more. Snelling is joined on the list by Cole Hamels (2003), Will Inman (2006), Madison Bumgarner (2008), Michael Piñeda (2008), Jose Fernandez (2012) and Andrew Painter (2022). Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-8.
