**LAST OUTING:** Alexander made his first start of the season with Nashville and fourth of his rehab assignment on June 25 vs. Norfolk. He allowed one unearned run in 4.2 innings, giving up four hits and striking out three in the 3-2 victory.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Alexander has two prior appearances (one start) against Memphis - one with Jacksonville and one with Nashville. He is 0-0 with a 3.86 ERA (4.2 IP/2 ER) and seven strikeouts in his career against the Redbirds.

#### **2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Placed on Milwaukee's 60-day injured list with a strained right rotator cuff on February 18... started rehab assignment at Arizona complex on June 9, making two starts
- Assignment transferred to Double-A Biloxi on June 20... after one start, moved to Nashville on June 25
