**LAST NIGHT:** The Amarillo Sod Poodles (29-30) defeated the Springfield Cardinals (26-33), 13-4, on Thursday night. The Cardinals struck first with a Rainiel Rodriguez solo homer to left in the opening frame. **Danny Serretti** drew a bases-loaded walk to match, but Springfield earned one back in the home second on a fielder's choice. **Cristofer Torin** sent a moonshot to left field, giving Amarillo the lead in the third. The line kept moving and saw **Demetrio Crisantes**, **Draw Jones**, and **Gavin Conticello** collect RBI knocks the cap the five-run fifth. The Sodpodes put together another five-run inning in the sixth, doing so in a two-out rally that featured a Jones bases-loaded walk and a Conticello grand slam. Amarillo starter **Daniel Eagen** finished off his sixth inning of work on the hill with his sixth strikeout of the night. Rodriguez checked in with his second homer of the night as his two-run dinger brought the Springfield run total to four in the seventh inning, but **Jansel Luis** responded with a two-run homer in the ninth to plate the 13th run of the night, completing the rout of the Cardinals.

**WHAT CONTI DO?:** Following a day at the plate where he collected a career-high 5 RBI, **Gavin Conticello** followed it up with another 5 RBI game last night... he is the first Texas League batter to drive in five runs in back-to-back games since Jake Rucker did so for Wichita (May 12-13, 2023) and the only Soddie to do so in club history...additionally, he became the only Sod Poodle to post back-to-back nights with 4+ hits as well as the first Texas Leaguer to do so since Nick Dunn accomplished it on June 18-20, 2023 with Springfield...with data as far back as 2005, Conticello is one of only three batters across 120 MiLB teams to post a 4+ hit, 5+ RBI night in back-to-back games...coincidentally, one of the other two to accomplish the feat was Héctor Rodríguez of the Triple-A Louisville Bats who also did so in the last two days...Conticello also turned 23 yesterday, making him only the eighth Double-A player since 2005 to hit a grand slam on their birthday...since May 28, the outfielder is batting .408 (20x49) with 5 home runs, 19 RBI, and a 1.218 OPS in 13 games.

**HITTING IS CONTAGIOUS:** The Sod Poodles are the only team in the Texas League this season to collect 17+ hits in back-to-back games, becoming the first Texas League to do so since Frisco (September 13-14, 2024)...they are also the first Texas League squad to score 13+ runs in consecutive contests...it is the first time in franchise history Amarillo has accomplished this feat.

**START ME UP:** Sodpodes starting pitchers are posting a 1.07 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) in the current series...since May 23, Amarillo starters are posting a 2.49 ERA (21 ER/76.0 IP), ranking first across Double-A baseball...the next best team by starter ERA over this span in AA is Biloxi (3.31).

**100 GRAND:** In the 2026 Amarillo vs. Springfield season series, a team has hit a grand slam in each of the six games played, with the first four belonging to Springfield before **Adrian De Leon** hit one Wednesday for the Sodpodes and **Gavin Conticello** doing so last night.

**KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES:** Since May 21, Jones has reached base safely in 15-of-16 games...he is batting .333 (19x57) with 13 runs, 6 stolen bases and a .441 OBP over this stretch...in the 8 games he's played in June, he is batting .400 (12x30) with a 1.067 OPS.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** Amarillo's 20 road wins in the first half match the 2023 and 2025 Sod Poodle squads for most away victories in a half in franchise history.

**GRAN TORIN-O:** Since May 15, **Cristofer Torin** ranks 4th in the Texas League in hits (29) while tying for 4th in runs (18) and placing 9th in AVG (.319).

**DOWN IN THE DESERT:** Wellington Aracena earned his first win of the year in High-A Hillsboro's 2-0 win last night...the righty struck out nine over six shutout innings and has not allowed a run in his last 11.2 IP.

### NOTES

#### SUMMARY

- ▶ Signed as an international free agent by the Diamondbacks out of the Dominican Republic on July 30, 2022.
- ▶ Making his first start at any level since August 22, 2025 when he was with Single-A Visalia...allowed four runs over 5.0 IP while striking out five Inland Empire batters.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Made his return to the Sod Poodles, appearing in his first game with Amarillo since September 11, 2025...made his first start since August 22, 2025 with Single-A Visalia.
- ▶ Put in the largest workload of his season, tossing 4.0 innings and throwing 60 pitches.
- ▶ Allowed two runs on four hits...was susceptible to the long ball and allowed two solo homers to the Drillers, matching a career-worst in home runs allowed in a game.

#### HOP TO IT

- ▶ Made his High-A debut on April 5 on the road at Eugene...allowed four runs on four hits over 2.0 IP while issuing one walk and striking out two.
- ▶ Placed on temporarily inactive list on 4/7...activated on 4/14.
- ▶ Put together a stretch of eight straight scoreless appearances from 4/19-5/24, accumulating 18.1 innings on the hill while allowing only seven hits and two walks, good for a 0.49 WHIP over that span...also fanned 20 batters over the eight-game stretch...batters were hitting .115 during the span.
- ▶ Fanned a season-high batters on 5/17 against Spokane.
- ▶ Picked up his first save of the year, doing so over 3.0 IP on 5/24 at Eugene.
- ▶ Among relievers in the Northwest League this season with at least 23.0 innings under their belt, he ranked 2nd in WHIP (0.90) and 4th in ERA (3.09) through June 4...also posted a 6.00 K/BB ratio, which ranked 1st in the NWL with the same parameters.

#### RIGHTEOUS

- ▶ Right-handed hitters in the Northwest League batted .156 with a .458 OPS against him this season compared to a .244 clip and a .710 OPS against lefties.
- ▶ Historically, he has fared better against lefties...LHH are batting .273 against him for his career while RHH are batting .291.

#### WELCOME BACK TO AMARILLO

- ▶ Made two appearances for the Sod Poodles in 2025.
- ▶ Tossed 3.2 innings out of the bullpen in his Soddies debut on August 28 at home against Northwest Arkansas...allowed one run on five hits with two strikeouts.
- ▶ Pitched for Amarillo only on other time last year, doing so on 9/11 where he tallied 4.0 IP with only one run allowed...struck out a pair.

#### MAY FLOWERS

- ▶ Had the best month of his 2025 campaign in May, going 3-0 with a 4.34 ERA over five games (one start)...struck out 13 batters over 18.2 IP.
- ▶ May has historically been his best month throughout his career...is 3-2 with a 3.83 ERA in 15 career games in May (five starts).

#### 2025 RECAP

- ▶ Went 8-7 across 23 appearances (13 starts) between Single-A Visalia and Amarillo last year...posted a 6.06 ERA combined and tallied 90.2 innings on the hill.
- ▶ Led the Rawhide in innings pitched (83.0) while ranking 5th in strikeouts (63).
