is the second of nine meetings between the two clubs this year, all to be played in Lawrenceville. Tonight is Wet Nose Wednesday, presented by New Country 101.5 (dogs free with paid owner on The Bank), and Xolos de Gwinnett Night (MiLB's Copa de la Diversión for Hispanic heritage).

VS. LOUISVILLE: Gwinnett is 29-21 (.580) in 50 games vs. Louisville at Coolray Field since 2009. The Stripers have won four straight home games over the Bats dating back to 5/14/21 (outscoring LOU 20-6 in that span), and have won the season home series over Louisville in each of the last four seasons (13-3 in that span).

THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder set a new single-game career high for innings pitched on Monday, working 8.0 IP (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) in the 2-0 win over Louisville. He carried a no-hit bid through 6.1 innings before Cristian Santana singled to center in the seventh. Elder's previous career high had been 7.0 innings, accomplished eight times (twice with Gwinnett this season).

• Cool(ray) Customer: In six career home starts with the Stripers, Elder is 2-1 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER in 35.0 IP), 0.89 WHIP, .146 BAA, and three quality starts.

ABOUT THE SHUTOUT: Elder (win, 8.0 IP, 2 H) and Seth Elledge (save, 1.0 IP, 0 H) combined on a two-hitter on Monday, Gwinnett's third shutout victory of the season (now 3-4 in shutout decisions). The Stripers hadn't blanked an opponent since posting back-to-back shutouts over Norfolk on 4/29 (8-0) and 4/30 (5-0).

KINGS OF THE "K": Following Elder's eight-strikeout start, Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 514 in 49 games (10.49 SO per game). That's seven more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 507 SO in 49G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-3rd, 56) and Touki Toussaint (T-8th, 48) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 5/31.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin notched hits in 16 of 20 games in May, batting a team-best .320 (24-for-75, 72B. 1 3B, 4 HR, 11 R, 11 RBI, 2 SB, .946 OPS) for the month. Overall, he has reached base safely in 35 of 40 games, hitting .297 (44-for-148, 10 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 22 R, 19 RBI, 3 SB, .848 OPS). His average ranks 16th in the IL

• GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (299-for-1,012, 61 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 135 R, 101 RBI, 10 SB, .770 OPS) with 83 multi-hit efforts in 275 games

**DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:** Delino DeShields Jr. is currently among IL leaders in on-base percentage (7th, .400), stolen bases (T-13th, 10), and walks (T-14th, 25). He has reached base safely in 29 of 36 games overall.

**TONIGHT:** The Stripers play game two of a six-game series A JOLT FROM JENISTA: After going homerless for 28 games vs. the Louisville Bats (Cincinnati Reds) at Coolray Field. It from 4/12-5/25, Greyson Jenista has homered in two of his last five games (#5-6). His solo clout (off LHP Zac Lowther) helped Gwinnett to a 3-2 win in game two of a doubleheader on 5/26 at Norfolk, and his three-run blast (off RHP Conner Greene) staked the Stripers to a 5-0 lead on 5/28 at Norfolk. Gwinnett is 5-0 when he homers.

> TROMP MASHED IN MAY: In May, Chadwick Tromp ranked among IL leaders in home runs (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), slugging percentage (T-7th, .632), extra-base hits (T-10th, 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48).

• Power Restored: On 5/26-G2 at Norfolk, he blasted a game-winning solo homer (#9) off LHP Kevin Smith for a last-at-bat 3-2 victory, his first clout since the final game of his 13-game hitting streak (.385 from 4/24-5/12), 11game RBI streak (23 RBI from 4/28-5/12), and ninegame extra-base hit streak (11 XBH from 5/1-5/12).

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters has reached base safely in five straight games, batting .294 (5-for-17, 4 2B, 4 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, .897 OPS) in that span. Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, he is batting .288 (19-for-66, 5 2B, 2 HR, 11 R, 7 RBI, 1 SB, .784 OPS) in 17 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .251 (145-for-577, 32 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 98 R, 55 RBI, 32 SB, .718 OPS) in 146 games.

**DEMERITTE RETURNS:** On 5/28, Atlanta optioned Travis Demeritte back to Gwinnett. Demeritte hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 161 of 189 games (85.2%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (185-for-651, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 126 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .946 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

#### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Huascar Ynoa makes his seventh start for the Stripers and ninth start of the season in game two of a six-game series vs. Louisville.

- GWN Career: Makes his 26th career appearance (23rd start) with Gwinnett dating back to his Triple-A debut in 2019 (4-7, 5.34 ERA, .261 BAA).
- Triple-A Splits: In 22 career starts, is 3-7 with a 5.50 ERA and .265 BAA ... In 13 career appearances at Coolray Field (12 starts), is 2-5 with a 5.05 ERA and .238 BAA.

**2022 WITH GWINNETT:** Since joining the Stripers on 4/19, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in five of his six starts ... 5/1 vs. NOR: Notched his lone win and quality start so far this year (6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO in 10-2 win) ... Since 5/2, is 0-2 with a 7.23 ERA (15 ER in 18.2 IP, 6 HR, 8 BB, 27 SO, .257 BAA) in his last four starts.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Braves' Opening Day Roster for the second time in his career (also in 2021) ... Served as Atlanta's fifth starter, going 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (10 ER in 6.2 IP) and .355 BAA over two starts ... Optioned to Gwinnett on 4/19.

2021 REGULAR SEASON: In an injury-shortened year with Atlanta, went 4-6 with a 4.05 ERA and .224 BAA in 18 games (17 starts) ... Was on the Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ... Won four consecutive starts from 4/23-5/9 (4-0, 1.11 ERA, .165 BAA), and drove in more runs (6) than he allowed (4) over that stretch ... Homered in back-to-back games (solo off CHC's Kyle Hendricks on 4/28, grand slam off WSH's Tanner Rainey on 5/4) ... Broke his right hand after departing the game on 5/16 at Milwaukee and was placed on the Injured List on 5/17 ... Transferred to the 60-day IL on 5/31 ... Was 4-2 with a 3.02 ERA in nine games (8 starts) prior to the injury ... Assigned to rehab in August and went 0-1 with an 8.71 ERA in three starts between High-A Rome (1 start) and Triple-A Gwinnett (2 starts) ...
