TAG IS IT: Luke Taggart made his return to the Grizzlies on Tuesday night after two months on the IL. Taggart has not allowed a run in three appearances this year logging 2.2 innings on the mound while striking out four. He struck out the first batter he faced Tuesday night. Taggart was 2-0 in a pair of rehab appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to the Grizzlies while registering a strikeout per inning.

UN-HINDERED: Jacob Hinderleider broke up Visalia's no-hit bid with two outs in the 7th inning, lacing a double that skipped up against the wall in right center field in a similar part of the field that he delivered a game-winning double at the beginning of May at the same field. Hinderleider leads the Grizzlies with a .288 batting average and is now tied for the team lead in doubles (11) with Kevin Fitzer and Kelvin Hidalgo.

RAW DEAL: The Grizzlies were shutout for the 8th time this season with three of those coming at the hands of the Visalia Rawhide at Valley Strong Ballpark. Five of the 13 meetings between the two teams have seen one side shutout the other and all of those have seen the home team win. Fresno is 5-8 against Visalia so far this year with 5 games, all this week, remaining against the Rawhide this season.
