ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (28-31) AT EL PASO CHIHUAHUAS (30-30)

RHP GABRIEL HUGHES (1-0, 4.76) vs. LHP OMAR CRUZ (0-2, 2.66)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 2-1 series lead after holding on for a 6-4 win last night ... The club has won nine of its last 12 and 12 of 19 ... Gabriel Hughes is expected to start for the Isotopes while Omar Cruz is slated to take the hill for the Chihuahuas.

VS EL PASO: Since the beginning of the 2023 campaign, Albuquerque is 37-23 against El Paso, including a 20-13 record at Southwest University Park.

XBH: Albuquerque's pitching staff did not allow an extra-base hit last night for just the second time in the last 210 games (also: May 2, 2025 vs. Salt Lake). It was their first time limiting the opposition to singles only in a road game since Aug. 26, 2023 at Oklahoma City.

HITS: The Isotopes tallied 14 hits, their 13th time reaching double-figures in the last 20 contests. Additionally, it tied for their most knocks in a game against El Paso this season (also: April 16).

MISCUES: The Isotopes committed at least three errors in a contest for the seventh time in 2025 yesterday, and it was the third occurrence in their last 11 contests. Albuquerque is 4-3 when recording a minimum of three miscues.

MARGIN: Four of Albuquerque's last five games have been decided by one or two runs, and they have emerged victorious in all of them. Overall, the Isotopes are 14-12 in such situations this year.

STARTING 9: All Isotopes starting position players recorded at least one hit for the seventh time this season yesterday, and fourth occurrence in the past 12 games (last: May 27 vs. Sugar Land)

TOPES DEBUT: Nick Anderson made his Rockies organizational debut last night. Is the 48th player to appear in a game for Albuquerque this season, and the third member of the 2020 American League champion Rays bullpen to be rostered by the Isotopes since last year (also: RHPs John Curtiss and Diego Castillo).

ASSIST: Sterlin Thompson recorded his second outfield assist of the season Thursday (also: May 29 vs. Sugar Land, Kennedy Corona out at home) and Albuquerque's 14th as a team.

.500: With a win today, the Isotopes will be just two games under .500 for the first time since April 24 (11-13) ... The club has not held an overall record above .500 since April 23, 2023, (11-10).

YF: Yanquiel Fernández finished 2-for-5 last night, and has a total of five hits in his last two contests. It marks the fourth time in 2025 that Fernández has at least two-straight multi-hit games (last: May 24-28, three-straight).

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia went 1-for-5 with a double, and has recorded a two-bagger in three consecutive games for the first time since Aug. 13-16, 2024 against Arizona and San Diego.

AMADOR: AAmador connected on his first home run since April 26 vs. Cincinnati (off Hunter Greene), a span of 81 at-bats. Amador has at least one hit in 13 of 16 Triple-A contests this year.

THE VET: Since beginning the season 4-for-21, Nola is 18-for-37 with five doubles and nine RBI in his last 10 games with Albuquerque. He has driven in eight runs in his past five starts, dating back to May 2 vs. Salt Lake.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel delivered his 19th multi-hit game of the season, one behind Ritter's team lead. Bernabel is slashing .393/.465/.541 over his last 16 contests, with seven extra-base hits during the stretch.

MR. BRUIN: Sean Bouchard tied a season-high for an Isotopes batter with three walks last night (also: Ryan Ritter, April 18 vs. El Paso and April 24 at Reno; Zac Veen, May 16 vs. Tacoma).

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson is slashing .373/.481/.672 with seven doubles, two triples, three homers and 12 RBI in his last 18 games. Has 11 hit-by-pitch, the most in the PCL.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is T-5th in doubles (16) ...**Sterlin Thompson** is T-6th in triples (3) ... **Julio Carreras** is 10th in stolen bases (11).

RITTER: Ryan Ritter had his contract selected by Colorado today, becoming the 8th player to make his eventual MLB debut for the Rockies this season.

LAST 12: Over Albuquerque's last 12 games, the club is first in Triple-A in average (.316), doubles (32), total bases (248), hits (136) and third in runs (80).

RISP: Over the first three games of the series, the club is 4-for-29 with runners in scoring position.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL: The Isotopes hold a -15 run differential on the year, 6th-best in the Pacific Coast League. Last year on June 6, the club owned a -149 run differential.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
