1-0, Once Again: The 1-0 loss for Columbus on Thursday night marked the sixth time a Clingstones game has finished with a 1-0 final score this season, the most in the Southern League ... The Clingstones are 2-4 in those games, but 2-1 in the second half ... The 12 shutout losses are the most in the Southern League this season.

McCruhlin: INF David McCabe went 1-for-3 on Thursday to continue a strong start to the second half ... Since 6/24, McCabe has batted .389 (21-54, 5 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI, .968 OPS), the 3rd-highest AVG in the Southern League during the second half (min. 40 AB) ... He has 5 multi-hit games, including in three-straight games from 7/5-7/8, the longest streak by a Columbus batter this season.

5 Is a Magic Number: Columbus is 18-6 in 24 games when scoring at least 5 runs this season ... The club is just 16-41 when not scoring 5 runs ... Columbus reached the 5-run mark 12 times in 56 games from 5/3-7/9, winning all 12 games before a 16-9 loss on Wednesday.

Quality Stuff: RHP Landon Harper worked the 1st quality start of his season and 2nd of his career on 7/10 vs. Pensacola (8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) ... It marked the longest start of his career and the 2nd time a Columbus pitcher has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings this season (Ian Mejia; 6/24 vs. BLX) ... With 24 quality starts this season, Columbus leads the Southern League and ranks 3rd in Double-A, trailing Midland (ATH, 25).

Hello, Expo: INF E.J. Exposito recorded the first home run of his Double-A career with a grand slam on Tuesday, becoming the 4th-different player to hit his first Double-A home run with Columbus ... Since 7/1, Exposito is batting .292 (7-for-24, 2B, HR, 8 RBI, .804 OPS) and has hit safely in all 7 games.

Different Debuts: RHP Blake Burkhalter was transferred from Columbus to Gwinnett on 7/10 for his Triple-A debut ... Burkhalter (2-5, 3.13 ERA in 14 starts) becomes the 3rd-different starting pitcher with Columbus to make his Triple-A debut this season, joining **Jhancarlos Lara** and **Didier Fuentes** ... In a corresponding move, Columbus added LHP Riley Frey from High-A Rome for his Double-A debut ... Frey becomes the 13th player to make his Double-A debut with Columbus this season, and the 4th starting pitcher to do so.

Mejia Returns: RHP Ian Mejia was transferred to Columbus on 7/10 after making his 2nd career Triple-A start with Gwinnett on 7/8 at IND (Loss, 4.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 3 SO) ... Prior to his promotion, Mejia went 8-1 with a 1.96 ERA (17 ER in 78.0 IP), 0.94 WHIP, .193 BAA and 8 quality starts, leading Columbus in each of those categories ... He posted a career best 36.2-inning scoreless stretch from 4/18-5/21 ... he ranked Top 10 in several SL pitching categories amongst qualified leaders.

Riley Frey makes his Double-A debut on 7/11 vs. Pensacola ... He becomes the 13th player and 4th starting pitcher to make his Double-A debut with Columbus this season ... It is his ninth start overall this season between Class-A Augusta, High-A Rome, and Columbus.

2025 Season: Was on the Opening Day roster with High-A Rome, making one appearance on 4/8 at Bowling Green (4.0 IP, 8 H, 6 R, 5 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 1 SO) ... Assigned to Class-A Augusta on 4/15, going 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (3 ER in 10.0 IP), 4 BB, 10 SO in 2 starts ... Returned to Rome on 4/23, going 0-3 with a 3.70 ERA (17 ER in 41.1 IP), 12 BB, 42 SO, 1.04 WHIP, .203 BAA over 10 games (6 starts) in his second stint with the Emperors ...
