#### DE LOS SANTOS WALK-OFF SEALS SWEEP

Deyvison De Los Santos' walk-off home run on Sunday sealed a 3-2 victory and series sweep of the Gwinnett Stripers. Carlos Rodriguez led off the game with a home run and Sandy León added a solo shot in the third to make it 2-0. The Jumbo Shrimp failed to capitalize on a myriad of opportunities, stranding 12 runners through the first seven innings. With two outs in the eighth, Maximo Acosta lined a two-run double to knot the score at two. In the ninth, Gwinnett had runners on first and second before losh Simpson entered the game and induced a double play.

#### **HOW SWEEP IT IS**

Since a four-game sweep of Chattanooga from July 18-21, 2019, the Jumbo Shrimp failed to record a sweep until they broomed Charlotte in a six-game set from April 7-13. Just two weeks after that, Jacksonville swept Gwinnett in another six-game series. Thus, the club has recorded two sweens in one season for the first time since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns swept five-game sets at Tennessee and vs. Mobile to win the final 10 games of the season en route to their most recent championship.

### **SEVEN DEADLY WINS**

Jacksonville's wild 3-2 victory on Sunday over Gwinnett was the club's seventh straight win, and ninth in the last 10 games. With the Jumbo Shrimp already registering an eight-game winning streak from April 5-13, this is marks the first time since 2017 that the club has notched two winning streaks of at least seven games in one season. Should Jacksonville win the series opener on Tuesday against Durham, they would hold two winnings streaks of at least eight games for the first time since 2006.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Sunday's 3-2 Jacksonville victory over Gwinnett was the 16th time in the last 18 games that the Jumbo Shrimp played a contest decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 13-3 (.813) in these closely-decided affairs. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 14-4 (.778) in games decided by no more than three runs, including 10-1 (.909) in one-run games. Those 10 one-run victories are by far the most in the minors; only one (Oklahoma City) of the other 119 MiLB teams has even eight wins by exactly one run.

### 'PFN PALS

Jacksonville starters have gone at least 5.0 innings just 13 times in 27 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.40 ERA, more than a full run better than second-place Memphis at 3.43) and .178 BAA, the best marks in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks third in the level in fewest hits allowed (81) and tied for sixth in strikeouts (139). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 127.2 innings through 26 games (4.7 per game), sixth-most in Triple-A.

#### BE STILL. MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 110.0 innings thus far through the season's first 27 games, a rate of just 4.1 per contest. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective; Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have posted the second-best ERA in Triple-A at 2.86 and issued just 26 walks, the fewest in the level. The club's starters also rank fifth in fewest hits allowed (92), sixth in BAA (.229) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (114). Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three runs or fewer in 11 consecutive games and in all but two contests this season.

### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 16 of their last 26 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank third in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 69 stolen bases.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville is now an extraordinary 16-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents 83-46 at VyStar Ballpark. Of the other 119 MiLB teams, only seven have double-digit wins at home, with none above 11 home triumphs... The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A with a 2.61 ERA. Second-place Nashville (3.13) is closer to fifth place Las Vegas than they are to Jacksonville... The Jumbo Shrimp set season highs for doubles (5) and XBH (6) on Sunday.

### ABOUT VALENTE

- -Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.
- -After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.
- -Bellozo made his major league debut for the Marlins on June 18, 2024 against the Royals from Kauffman Stadium in Kansas City. He tossed 5.0 shutout innings, scattering two hits and a walk with two strikeouts
- -Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in the 2022-23 and 2023-24 offseasons

### 2025 SEASON

-Bellozo was optioned to Jacksonville on March 30 and again on April 10.

### 2024 SEASON

- -Bellozo posted reverse platoon splits; In 301 plate appearances, right-handed hitters batted .285/.340/.522/.862 against him. In comparison, over 280 plate appearances, lefties slashed .217/.286/.395/.681 against him.
- -Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.
- -At the time of his promotion to Triple-A, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

### 2023 SEASON

- -In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).
- -As a starter with Asheville, Bellozo posted an 0-3 record and 7.34 ERA in 13 starts (57.2 IP, 65 H, 19 BB, 53 K, .284 BAA). Comparatively, as a reliever, he was 3-0 with a 4.38 ERA in nine appearances (37.0 IP, 41 H, 7 BB, 41 K, .273 BAA)
