SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 5-4, in 10 innings to close the series. After Erie took a 1-0 lead in the top of the second, **Armani Smith** tied the game with a single in the bottom of the inning. Parker Meadows gave Erie a 2-1 lead in the fourth with an RBI single. In the fifth, **Jacob Heyward** tied the score with a single and **Will Wilson** gave Richmond a 4-2 lead with a two-run homer. Meadows hit a sact fly in the sixth and Dane Myers tied the score with a solo homer in the ninth. In the bottom of the 10th, **Diego Rincones** won the game with a walk-off single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams met for a six-game series in Harrisburg from May 10-15, with Richmond winning four of those games. The Flying Squirrels and Senators meet for one more series this year, a six-game set at The Diamond from August 30-September 4. On the year, Richmond is 6-4 in series openers, including a 3-2 mark on the road.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Richmond leads the Southwest Division by one game over Akron and two games over Erie. The Flying Squirrels hold the tiebreaker against both teams with a winning head-to-head record. Fourteen games remain before the Eastern League's first half closes on June 26. The first-half and second-half division champions will meet in a best-of-three series in the Eastern League Postseason, followed by a best-of-three championship series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won 10-of-13 games since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won five-of-six at home against the SeaWolves, moving into first place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 623 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 242 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.03 ERA (5 ER/43.2 IP) over the last 12 games since May 31.

THE SENATORS are riding a five-game winning streak after going 1-7 in their previous eight games. Last week, Harrisburg won five-of-seven against the Baysox at home. The Senators have allowed one run in each of their last three games. Harrisburg's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including C Drew Millas (19), SS Jackson Cluff (21) and RHP Jake Irvin (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his 12th start of the season and third against the Senators. He last pitched on Wednesday against the SeaWolves at The Diamond and fired six scoreless innings, combining for a shutout with John Russell and Chris Wright. It was his second scoreless start of the season. He also pitched 6.2 scoreless innings, his longest that week on May 15 and allowed six runs (four earned) in 1.0+ innings. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. For more on Brickhouse, see page two.

FOR HARRISENG: Right-hander Franklyn Kilome makes fifth appearance and fourth start of the season. Last time out, Kilome pitched five innings and allowed a season-high four runs (three earned) in a loss against the Baysox on Wednesday. Kilome signed as a free agent with the Nationals on April 26. He was originally signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic in 2013. He pitched in the Eastern League with Reading in 2017 and 2018 before being traded to the Mets on July 27, 2018 for INF Asdrubal Cabrera. Kilome finished the 2018 season with seven starts for Binghamton in the EL. He missed the entire 2019 season after having Tommy John surgery but returned in 2020 to make his MLB debut for the Mets. Kilome spent the entire 2021 season with the Mets' Triple-A affiliate in Syracuse, going 3-3 with a 3.91 ERA in 21 outings (5 starts).

#WINNING: The Flying Squirrels have their best record in franchise history through 57 games at 33-24, ahead of 32-25 starts in 2013 and 2014. The Flying Squirrels' best start through 58 games is 33-25, which was set in 2014 and can be surpassed with a win tonight.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,061) and total attendance (181,817). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 75 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (78). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 16 homers on the season, with 13 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 182 home runs.

A LITTLE RELIEF: The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.03 ERA (5 ER/43.2 IP) over the last 12 games since May 31. In that stretch, **Blake Rivera** has made three scoreless outings with 6.0 scoreless innings. **John Russell** has worked four straight scoreless outings in that span, totaling 4.2 innings. **Chris Wright** and Dabovich have combined to convert four of the team's five save opportunities in that stretch.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 23 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .294 (25-for-85) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 16 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on May 7 at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in the 8-4 win over the 'Ducks on May 9. On Saturday, he lifted a walk-off sac fly in the bottom of the ninth for a 6-5 win over Erie.

FITZ ON FIRE: After opening the season hit .162 through May 26, Tyler Fitzgerald is batting .326 (15-for-46) with four homers, five doubles and nine RBIs over his last 13 games since May 27. On May 29, Fitzgerald homered twice and tied a single-game franchise record with five hits. He also set new single-game franchise records with five runs scored and 13 total bases. He clubbed his eighth homer of the year in Saturday's win over the SeaWolves.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .342 (28-for-82) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 17 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on Tuesday. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. He collected two walks in Saturday's game, extending his on-base steak to 24 games, which is the longest active streak in the league and tied for the second-longest this year overall.

ARMANI ARRIVES: After going hitless in his Double-A debut on May 15, Armani Smith has picked up at least one hit in 12-ofhis-last-15 games played. During that 15-game span since May 17, Smith is batting .339 (19-for-56) with a homer, four doubles, a triple, five RBIs, seven runs scored and five walks. He hit his first Double-A homer on Thursday against the SeaWolves.

TOASTY: Frankie Tostado is hitless over his last three games, going 0-for-12 in that span with three strikeouts. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 40 of his 50 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.307), tied for third in hits (61) and seventh in total bases (96).

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 16th homer of the season on Friday night, his third straight game with a homer. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (20). He has hit 13 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvali** in 2013. With two homers on May 29 against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking seven in his last 14 games since May 26.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.307), tied for third in hits (61) and seventh in total bases (96). Sean Roby is second in home runs (16) and tied for eighth in SLG (.506). Mike Gigliotti is 10th in walks (27) and tied for eighth in steals (13). Ryan Walker is first in wins (6). Chris Wright is tied for fourth in saves (6).

WHERE THE SENATORS RANK: In the Eastern League, Wilson Garcia is 10th in batting average (.287), tied for fifth in hits (56) and tied for eighth in total bases (94). Jake Alu is tied for third in doubles (15). Justin Connell is tied for fifth in runs scored (36). Matt Brill is second in saves (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), R.J. Dabovich (17), Ricardo Genoves (24) and Chris Wright (27). Franklin Labour is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Simon Whiteman is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Brett Auerbach (27), Genoves (29) and Kai-Wei Teng (30). Harrison is *Baseball America*'s No. 64 overall prospect.


