

LAST GAME

Yet another ninth-inning heartbreak, the Bowie Baysox lost another contest to the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Friday, falling 5-2. Bowie hit back-to-back home runs in the eighth inning to tie the game, but Griffin McLarty allowed a three-run home run in the top of the ninth inning to dash Bowie's hopes. Both starting pitchers, Chayce McDermott for Bowie and Kyle Harrison for Richmond, worked strong over their starts, allowing only one hit over four innings, but Richmond used their one hit to take the lead in the third inning. After Richmond pushed further with a run in the eighth, Maverick Handley and Chris Givin blasted back-toback home runs to tie the games. Just as soon as Bowie had tied the game, McLarty walked two batters in the ninth and allowed a three-run home run.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

In a series that (Bowie hopes) should preview the first round of the Eastern League playoffs, Bowie will try to make one more charge against the team that they have battled tightly with this seaosn. While Richmond went 7-2 against Bowie in the first half of the season, Bowie flipped the record around against Richmond in the second half, bringing the season series to an even 9-9. While they were able to win the first half of the season in a tiebreak with Akron, the second half has been much more difficult for the Squirrels, as they have the league's worst record in the half. Richmond has relied constantly on power this season, as they have the third-most home runs in the league, despite sporting the lowest batting average.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Taiwan native Kai-Wei Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins in 2017, but was sent to San Francisco at the trade deadline as part of the Sam Dyson deal in 2019. While Teng did run into some contact and walks in his 2021 campaign with High-A Eugene, he still found the time to strike out 142 batters in just 95.2 innings, and his 153 strikeouts this year are the second-most in the league. Bowie has met Teng already four times this season, as he fired five shutout frames in his first start of the season, but Bowie got him back for six runs in four innings at the end of April, Bowie's only win of their six-game series in Richmond. At the start of July, Bowie had a series of timely hits, as well as a home run by Hudson Haskin during a 4-2 win, but Teng still struck out seven in the outing. In his last start against the Baysox, Teng was chased in the second inning as Bowie built a 6-0 lead, but Bowie still lost the game. On the mound, Teng features a low-90s fastball, but will often use a slider and a changeup all throughout at bats

NOT THEIR FAVORITE INNING

Bowie would be a much better team this season if baseball games ended after eight innings. Bowie has a -23 run differential in the ninth inning this season the worst in the entire league, and their worst differential in any inning this season. Their 33 runs scored in the ninth inning is the fewest in the Eastern League this season. Bowie's walk-off losses have hurt them this season, as they have been dealt 12 walk-offs, tied for the most in Minor League Baseball. Bowie has lost five games this season where they had a lead in the ninth inning.

NORBY KNOWS HOW TO HIT

Connor Norby is taking on all pitches lately, after leading off for most of his Bowie tenure, Norby shifted to the second and third roles in the lineup starting on 8/18, and has gone 28-for-71 (.394) since, with two multi-home run games, and seven home runs total. Combined with his time spent at High-A, Norby has 23 home runs this season, tied for the most in the Orioles minor league system. Norby is already has six home runs in the first inning of games, tied for the most in the Easter the Easter this season.

LATE ARRIVALS

Bowie has not been able to get their offense going against opposing starting pitchers lately. So far in September, opposing starting pitchers have fired 42.2 innings, and allowed only 14 runs, a 2.95 ERA. The strong opposition has not been fully able to seal the deal, however, as opposing starters have only won two agames out of Bowie's last seven losses.

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.272/.370/.469) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 947 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Bowie has also stranded the most runners in scoring position in the league (701). Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base (561). In this series, Bowie is only 3-for-31 (.097) with runners in scoring position.
