The Lugnuts are 6-11 against the Whitecaps this season. Tonight is also a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday, featuring \$2 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts.

Last Night: Whitecaps 5, Lugnuts 3. West Michigan rallied for three runs in the ninth inning against Charles Hall, tying the game on an RBI single from Gage Workman and taking the lead on a two-run single from Andrew Jenkins, to defeat the Lugnuts in the first two games of the series.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa call the action on Bally Live, MiLB.TV and StreamGuys.

On Deck: Tomorrow is the final Copa night of the year, with the Lansing Locos in action; Saturday is Fan Appreciation Night; and Sunday is Accessibility Day on a Capital City Market Kids Day. Then the Lugnuts head out to Lake County to wrap up the season.

Roster Movement: Catcher Daniel Susac was promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday, becoming the 17th 2023 Lugnut to join the RockHounds - nine position players, eight pitchers. In a corresponding move, infielder Joshwan Wright was activated from the Injured List and pitcher Luis Morales was added to the Lugnuts' roster from Stockton. Morales is scheduled to start tomorrow.

Home Cooking: The Nuts lead the league in home batting average (.260), home base hits (519) and home total bases (819).

Two for the Price of One: Lansing leads the league with 111 double plays turned, nine more than second-place Peoria.

Starting Strong: In a losing cause yesterday, Jacob Watters continued the Lugnuts' stretch of improved starting pitching, striking out seven in 4 2/3 scoreless innings. Over the last eight games, Lugnuts starters have allowed eight runs on 19 hits in 39 2/3 innings, striking out 48 batters in that span

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 25 pitchers (not including Danny Bautista, Jr., who tossed one inning as a position-playerpitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 14 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 21 in 26 games played in August (81%).

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton)

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland and the 2022 first-round pick, catcher **Daniel Susac**, was promoted today.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Noah Syndergaard struck out nine South Bend Silver Hawks in five innings of one-hit shutout ball, and the Lugnuts scored five runs in the 7th for a 5-4 win at The Cove. (The Hawks scored all four of their runs in the 8th.)

2013: After the Whitecaps scored two runs in the top of the 9th to tie the game, 4-4, Kevin Patterson's walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 9th gave the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory.

2016: The Lugnuts welcomed Bill Johnston, their 8,000,000th fan and Michigan Lottery Lugnut, to Cooley Law School Stadium, part of a crowd of 4,704 that watched the Nuts defeat Bowling Green, 3-1.

2022: The pitching matchup featured 2022 fourth-rounder Jacob Watters in his Nuts debut (1 IP, 1 UER, 3 BB) against MLB rehabber Wade Miley for South Bend, but the game was decided by a two-run Pablo Aliendo homer in the fifth in a 4-2 loss at Four Winds Field.

In a Nutshell: Added to Lansing roster from Stockton on August 15, 2023, to replace the promoted Brady Basso... had previously been a member of the Lugnuts from April 14-May 10, 2022 before getting transferred to Stockton for the rest of the season.

Strong First Impression: Pitched in piggyback relief on August 17 vs. Great Lakes, following Jacob Watters (2 2/3) and John Beller (1 1/3)... fired five scoreless innings, whiffing six... struck out first two batters faced in a perfect 5th... pitched around a one-out Griffin Lockwood-Powell single in the 6th... allowed a one-out Kenneth Betancourt single but erased it with a Chris Alleyne double-play ball in the 7th... walked two batters but stranded them in the 8th... gave up a one-out Luis Guerra single in the 9th but induced second double-play ball to finish fifth scoreless frame... 65 pitches, 40 strikes.

Last Time Out: Pitching at Dayton on August 24, James struck out the side around a walk in the 1st inning, struck out the side again in the 2nd inning around a Hector Rodriguez double, worked a perfect 3rd inning, stranded a two-out walk and single in the 4th inning, and allowed a run on a leadoff double and a sacrifice fly in the 5th inning... 81 pitches, 52 strikeouts... Lugnuts went on to win, 3-2.

Path to Lansing: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training last season before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... this season, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation.

Changing Things Up: Fellow Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels credits James for teaching him his current change-up grip last year while with Stockton... James's sinking change-up is considered his best pitch.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team this year... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out.
