#### **FRES-NOTES**

**JUNE BLOOM:** The Grizzlies .252 team batting average is second in the California League in May as is the 111 hits in the first 13 games of the month. Fresno is also second with 7 home runs in the first two weeks of June and is slugging .363 so far. Visalia has managed to maximize their baserunners as the Rawhide are 10-3 in June but are hitting just .203 through the 13 games.

**STINGY STAFFS:** The Grizzlies pitching staff has posted a 3.49 ERA in 13 games this June, good for third in the California League. Visalia has posted a league best 2.66 ERA to spur Visalia to a strong start to the month of June. While the Grizzlies have allowed just 46 earned runs in the month of June, Visalia has allowed just 38 total runs.

**TIGER BLOOD:** Of the Grizzlies top four hitters in the month of June, only Kelvin Hidalgo did not play at Clemson before turning pro. Jimmy Obertop delivered a multi-hit game on Sunday as is batting .375 in three games while Jacob Hinderleider and Blake Wright are each hitting above .290 so far. Hidalgo has been the Grizzlies hottest hitter in June batting .320 with 9 extra-base hits.
