### FRES-NOTES

**MENDEZ'S MONSTROUS GAME PROPELS GRIZZLIES PAST GIANTS:** The Fresno Grizzlies (3-3, 41-30) vanquished the San Jose Giants (4-2, 41-30) 6-1 Thursday evening from Excite Ballpark. Fresno broke their four-game losing skid to San Jose, tying the season-series up at nine wins apiece. The Grizzlies also halted their minor three-game losing streak overall. The Grizzlies offense pounded 14 hits, their second-most in a game this season. Five of the first six batters in the Fresno lineup notched a multi-hit game, which included the first four of the order. Luis Mendez led the charge with a career-night, mashing three extra-base hits. Mendez whacked a pair of wallops and a double, tallying three RBI, while adding three runs. It was the second multi-homer game in the last four days and of the season for Fresno (Braylen Wimmer last Sunday, June 23 vs. Stockton). Mendez now has three longballs this season, surpassing his total from last year. Andy Perez drove in a pair of runs from a single and sacrifice fly. Perez laced a double, giving the Grizzlies at least one double in 20 of their last 21 contests. Wimmer recorded three hits and one run, which included picking up a double as well. He extended his hit streak to 10 games, the third Grizzlies batter (Perez and Felix Tena, twice) to reach a double-digit streak in 2024. Jason Hinchman and Caleb Hobson collected two hits each with the latter swatting a triple. The run support was enough for a quartet of Fresno arms, who pooled together 11 strikeouts. Austin Emener tossed four and two-thirds innings of sensational ball. Emener allowed one run (earned), on four hits and no walks while striking out seven. Unfortunately, the southpaw left with a forearm injury with two outs in the fifth (hopefully nothing serious). Brady Hill (2-1) took over for Emener and was awarded the decision after pitching past the fifth. Hill retired all four batters he faced, fanning one of them. In his professional career, Hill has relinquished four wins, which have all come at Excite Ballpark, his old college stomping grounds. Cade Denton continued his outstanding work out of the bullpen, lowering his ERA to 0.71. Denton chucked one and one-third scoreless frames, issuing the only walk of the contest. Bryson Hammer wrapped up the evening with one and two-thirds shutout innings.

**GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Excite Ballpark. This is the fourth of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the final set in San Jose. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 56-49 overall (2024 season series tied 9-9) in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

**FROM FRIEND TO FOE:** The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Ywain Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

**JACK OF ALL TRADES:** Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #19 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney is from Illinois and grew up with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

**MAHONEY'S MASTERFUL COMPLETE GAME SHUTOUT RECEIVES HONORS:** Grizzlies' RHP Jack Mahoney was selected by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23. Mahoney (4-4, win) was almost unhittable in his 12th start of the season on Friday, June 21, giving Fresno their seventh shutout victory of the year. Mahoney went the distance with catcher Ben McCabe, firing a nine-inning complete game shutout, the first in Minor League Baseball this season. The only other Minor League pitcher to toss a nine-inning complete game in 2024 was fellow Rockies' and former Grizzlies lefty Sean Sullivan with High-A Spokane. Mahoney faced two over the minimum, retiring the first 16 batters in the contest. He allowed a one-out single to Carlos Franco in the sixth and a two-out double to Nelson Beltrán in the eighth. Mahoney did not issue a walk and fanned four batters. He struck out half of those batters in the first inning and finished the complete game shutout with another punchout, this time of Derek Salom. Mahoney ended his unbelievable feat with 95 pitches (69 strikes), yielding 18 groundouts. He received a lot of defensive support as Caleb Hobson made an unreal catch in center to end the fourth and his infielders recorded multiple throw outs. Mahoney has not allowed a run in 15 straight innings, spanning two starts.

**JACK MAHONEY JOINS ELITE COMPANY:** The Rockies #19 prospect became the 19th pitcher in Grizzlies history to notch a complete game shutout (Jack Mahoney wears #19 in his jersey as well) and the first since the club entered Single-A in 2021. Mahoney joins Chris Heston (two complete game shutouts), Chris Begg, Jason Berken, Darin Blood, Madison Bumgarner, Austin Fleet, Ryan Jensen, Sun-Woo Kim, Andrew Kown, Shane Loux, Noah Lowery, Ramon Ortiz, Brad Peacock, Brady Rodgers, Cy Snead, Steve Soderstrom, Cesar Valdez and Barry Zito as Grizzlies' pitchers to accomplish the feat (done 20 times overall). The most recent complete game shutout in Fresno history was thrown by Cy Snead (Houston Astros), who did it on June 21, 2018 versus Albuquerque (Rockies affiliate) at Chukchansi Park, exactly six years ago to the date (also an 8-0 final). There have been 58 total complete games in Grizzlies history, with the last three involving a Rockies affiliate. This was the first complete game comprising of the Grizzlies and Rockies since joining ties in 2021.

**NO DENT ON CADE'S ERA:** Grizzlies' RHP Cade Denton has made 12 appearances out of the bullpen since joining Fresno on May 21st. Denton is sporting a 0.71 ERA and 0.63 WHIP while opponents are hitting .093 against him (L/R: 11/0.080). In 12.2 innings, Denton has allowed two runs (one earned), on four hits, four walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 13. Over seven games, the Rockies #29 prospect has not permitted a run at home this season. In 6.2 frames, Denton has given up one hit and one walk while striking out five.

**WIMMER, WIMMER CHICKEN DINNER IN JUNE:** Grizzlies' INF Braylen Wimmer has had an extraordinary month of June. Over 21 games, Wimmer is 33-for-80 (.413 AVG/.484 OBP/.700 SLG/1.184 OPS) with five homers, eight doubles, 16 RBI, 19 runs, nine walks, two hit-by-pitches and five stolen bases. During the month, Wimmer is rocking a 10-game hit streak (June 15-27), where he is 20-for-41 (.488) with three homers, four doubles, 10 RBI, 11 runs, five walks, one hit-by-pitch and three stolen bases. Wimmer has tallied 10 multi-hit games, five multi-run contests, and four multi-RBI games in June as well. The South Carolina product has also hit three of his five homers in a span of two games (June 23, 25). Overall, Wimmer leads the team with nine longballs with a trio of them coming at Excite Ballpark in San Jose.

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 54 times in 128 plate appearances (27 games; 42% reaching base in leadoff spot). In nine of those 27 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 29 runs. Part of Hobson's success is first plate appearance of the game, where he is 7-for-19 with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch. Six of his seven hits have been singles with two of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 17 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (22/25 in stolen bases on the season).
